Fifty players representing 36 institutions were recognized on the inaugural Daktronics, Inc., NCAA Division II All-America Baseball Team.

Francis Marion's Dylan Owen and first baseman Erik Lovett from Mount Olive were named national Pitcher and Player of the Year respectively.

Owen pitched the Patriots to a 36-18 season and a third-place regular season finish in the Peachbelt Conference. Owen, a two-time PBC Pitcher of the Year, set a conference career record at 334 strikeouts.

Lovett led the Trojans to the finals of the South Atlantic Regional, hitting .422 with 21 homers and 78 RBI. Lovett, the Carolinas-Virginia Athletic Conference Player of the Year, carried the Trojans to the regular season and tournament titles in the CVAC.

Rounding out the first team, which had 15 players from 15 teams, were starting pitchers Jon Bjelland (Minnesota State-Mankato), Justin Phillips (Harding) and Brett Lysander (Sonoma State); relief pitcher Jameson Maj (Abilene Christian); second baseman Maikol Gonzalez (Tusculum); third baseman Casey Jirsa (Ashland); shortstop Matt Bodenchuk (Mesa State); catcher Ben Barrone (Winona State); designated hitter Miguel Porchas (New Mexico Highlands); utility player (SP/CF) Matt Borman (Concordia-St. Paul) and outfielders Josh Miller (West Virginia State), Chance Beasley (Ouachita Baptist) and Nicolas Boisvert (Lynn).

Second team members were starting pitchers Nick Beach (Gand Valley State), Kevin Hammonds (Tusculum), Jason Mills (Kutztown) and Kevin Ferguson (Tampa); reliever Paige Dumont (Sonoma State); first baseman Josh Paul (Central Missouri); second baseman Cody Lusero (Nebraska-Kearney); third baseman Casey Jirsa (Ashland); shortstop Brandon Halstead (West Virginia State); catcher Breck Draper (Central Oklahoma); designated hitter Bryce Columbus (Central Oklahoma); utility (LF/C) Dustin Richardson (Mount Olive) and outfielders Dustin Jones (Wayne State-Neb.), Mitch Walser (Upper Iowa) and Chris Weimer (Nebraska-Omaha).

Starting pitchers Brett Durand (Delta State), Keith Barrett (Ouachita Baptist), Brett Armour (Mesa State) and Tim Cloyd (Nebraska-Omaha); reliever Jonathan Holt (Tampa); first baseman Matt Cantele (UC San Diego); second baseman Alex Castellanos (Belmont Abbey); third baseman Craig Corrado (Tampa); shortstop Steve Condotta (Florida Tech); designated hitter Seth Waller (Belmont Abbey); utility player (RP/IF) Mike McCardell (Kutztown) and outfielders JD Pruitt (Montevallo), David Anderson (New Haven) and Justin Mills (Georgia College & State) make up the third team.

Five players who each garnered at least 33 percent of the votes were named honorable mention: Felician first baseman Frank Quintana, Mercyhurst outfielder David Lough, Wingate DH Josh Benton, utility player Clay Calfee of Angelo State and reliever Nick Fellman of Minnesota State-Mankato.
