### The Series:

The fifth ranked Mules (34-5, 16-2 MIAA) start a four-game series with Fort Hays State on Friday after taking all four games from the SBU Bearcats last week. The Tigers (23-12, 11-7 MIAA) come into the week ranked fourth in the MIAA while the Mules have won seven in a row and lead the conference race by more than three games.

### Mules take out the brooms for Bearcats

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The fifth ranked University of Central Missouri Mules brought out the brooms this weekend for a four game sweep of Southwest Baptist. They grabbed wins of 8-6, 17-6, 10-3, and a come-from behind 5-4 game.

Senior first baseman **Josh Paul** continued his hitting assault as he finished the week with six home runs and a .696 batting average along with his amazing 19 RBI.

In game one on Thursday, the Mules (34-5, 16-2 MIAA) went out to a 3-0 lead before the Bearcats came back with four runs in the third. Three of those runs were unearned because of Mule errors. Starter **Kris Webber** (7-0) went into the eighth inning before giving up a two-run homer with an 8-4 lead. **Matt Michals** came in to finish off the frame before closer **Bryan Collins** came in to close out the final inning. UCM had 11 hits in the outing as **Blaine Rutledge** and **Will Feil** had three RBI apiece to lead the attack.

The next day, **Seth Gilleland** (8-0) tossed five shutout frames before sitting down with an 11-0 lead and the cold weather. The Bearcats tagged **Mark Carey** for six runs in the next inning without registering an out before **Danny Potje** came in to throw the final three clips and grab the save. Paul was the offensive star, hitting two home runs and tying a school record with five hits in the game (5-of-5 with a walk). He also recorded an outstanding eight RBI, more than the entire SBU team with six runs total.

In game three of the series, Central Missouri came back from a 2-0 deficit in the third to score five

unanswered runs. The Bearcats tacked one on in the fifth before the Mules answered with five more runs to make it a rout. **Ron Martin** (3-1) grabbed the win after tossing the first 5.1 innings before **Chris Radliff** finished off some trouble in the sixth. **Iain Dykins** started a solid day with a 3-of-3 and three RBI performance, while Paul and **Chris Brown** snagged a couple hits and RBI apiece.

The final game of the stand was the toughest though. **Brandon Morris** got the start but allowed three first inning runs before finishing the frame. Michals came in the second and got two outs before suffering an elbow injury. **Travis Pyatt** was then forced to enter the game in the middle of the second frame. He came up big though, throwing 3.2 innings and holding the Bearcats to a run in the fifth. The Mules bats finally came alive in the bottom half of the fifth though. Feil doubled to center to move runners to second and third with no outs. **Brian McBryde** drove in a run off a ground ball to the shortstop then Mochizuki walked to put runners at the corners. Brown crushed a double to the left field fence to score a second run before Dykins followed that with another double off the left field fence to tie the game.

Radliff came in relief of Pyatt and closed out the sixth and breezed through the seventh to give the Mules a chance for heroics. Brown reached on a throwing error by the pitcher on a bunt to lead off the frame before Dykins singled on the next at bat. The Bearcats intentionally walked Paul to load the bases with no outs. The Bearcats got an out at home on the next at-bat but a wild pitch with Perez at the dish enabled Dykins to dive into home for the win.

## The Coaches



Head Coach **Darin Hendrickson** is in his fourth season with University of Central Missouri baseball program. Named the Mules' 12th head coach in the summer of 2003, Hendrickson has now put his stamp on one of the top baseball teams in NCAA Division II. The 37-year-old native of Granite City, Ill. has compiled a 192-38 record in his fourth season at the helm.

He has a career NCAA record of 318-92, including his four seasons at Fontbonne, and has had nine players picked in the Major League Draft in his three seasons at Central Missouri.

**Rick Sabath** is in his first season as head coach at Fort Hays after serving last season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Kansas. He has been the head coach at both Cloud County and Garden City Community Colleges from 2000-05. A 1994 graduate of FHSU, he earned his masters in 1996 from Kansas.

## The Series

The Mules lead the Tigers 7-1 in the overall series and won the 2004 and 2005 meetings by 13-2 and 7-2 margins. The last time FHSU defeated UCM was back in 1996 when it took the middle game of a three-game stretch in Warrensburg. The Mules are also 2-0 against the Tigers in Hays, winning both games in 1995.

## Scouting the Tigers

Fort Hays State comes into the game with a 23-12 overall mark and are led by hot hitting Luke Dreiling, who hit four home runs in a doubleheader against Washburn on Wednesday. He is hitting .394 with 10 homers and 41 RBI. Dusty Washburn is next on the list with a .387 average and league-high 18 doubles. As a team the Tigers hit .308 and have an ERA of 5.22 to put them at third in the MIAA. Closer Tyler Nuss leads the MIAA in saves with seven while boasting a 2.55 ERA. Bobby Lewton leads the squad in wins with five and a 6.06 ERA.

## Hendrickson Hits Milestones

Head Coach Darin Hendrickson is now ranked third on the all-time win list at UCM after passing Stu Rogers this season. He now sits with 192 victories as a Mule and is chasing the late Bob Tompkins, who racked up 248 during his 15-year career. Hendrickson also has the best winning percentage of any coach in school history at an outstanding 83.5 percent (192-38).

## Mules Baseball: Winningest Team of the Millenium

The University of Central Missouri baseball program has had unprecedented success in the last 20 years and has been even more impressive since 2000. With the win over SBU last Saturday, UCM has a 400-77 overall record since 2000, the most wins of any program in NCAA Division I, II, or III.

### *Mules: Defending the Home Turf*

The Mules are currently riding a 22-game home winning streak at Crane Stadium. It is the longest current streak in the MIAA. Mules athletics have also teamed up for an exciting streak. No Mules team sport has lost a home game since the wrestlers on February 8 to top-ranked Central Oklahoma.

On a side note, no team has lost a home game with Shawn Jones as the play-by-play voice since football dropped to second-ranked Northwest Missouri on October 28.

### *Going, Going...Gone!!*

Mules senior first baseman **Josh Paul** was named the Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week on Monday after his hitting display last week. He hit .696 in the six games with six home runs and an amazing 19 RBI. He was the only non-Division I player to receive the honor.

The last Central Missouri player to receive the honor was Danny Powers back in the record breaking 2005 season.

He helped the fifth ranked Mules to a 6-0 record last week. Paul actually hit nine home runs in a seven game stretch counting three games at Missouri Western last weekend.

He hit three home runs in a game against Truman on Tuesday after hitting one in the first game of that day. He is the first person since National Position Player of the Year Shawn Callahan in 2005 to hit three homers in a game.

Paul also knocked in eight RBI and tied a school record with five hits against SBU on Friday night. He ended that game on a two run "walk off" homer to run rule the Bearcats 17-6. For the week, he had an on base percentage of .750 and a slugging percentage of an amazing 1.696.

### *Maui Time*

Central Missouri leadoff hitter and shortstop **Gered Mochizuki** leads the 4th ranked Mules with a .407 batting average, 57 hits, 40 runs, 14 doubles, 32 walks, 15 stolen bases, and a .523 on-base percentage. He is the only returning All-American and also leads the MIAA in hits.

### *Back on Top in the MIAA*

The Mules currently lead the MIAA with a .333 batting average, 25 triples, 39 home runs, 425 hits, and 68 stolen bases. They really dominate the league in pitching though. With a team ERA of 2.67, the next closest team is NWMSU at 4.52. Central Missouri leads the conference in every major statistical category for pitching.

### *Dirty Rotation*

The Central Missouri Mules baseball squad has returned to form on the mound after the 2005 Major League Draft took five pitchers. The top five starters in 2007 have ERA's under 4.0 with the top two combining for a 15-0 record. Starter **Seth Gilleland** (8-0) has been named MIAA Pitcher of the Week two times while **Kris Webber** (7-0) has been named once. They are ranked one and two in the MIAA in pitching as Gilleland boasts a 1.92 ERA and Webber with a 1.35 average.

Closer **Bryan Collins** has four saves and a 0.44 ERA while set up man/closer **Chris Radliff** has a 1.04 ERA and two saves along with three wins and was named the MIAA Pitcher of the Week on Monday. Meanwhile, **Brandon Morris** has a perfect 4-0 record this season, adding to his MIAA Freshman of the Year season of 9-0 last year.

### *National Leaders*

The Mules also have several players ranked on the national scene in Division II. The team ERA of 2.67 ranks fourth in the nation, the strikeouts per game of 9.0 ranks third, and the Mules winning percentage of .872 is fifth.

Individually, Seth Gilleland and Kris Webber are ranked third and 11th in the nation in wins while Blaine Rutledge is seventh in triples per game at .20. Josh Paul is also 16th in home runs with 11.
