### The Games:

The eighth ranked Mules (48-11) go into the NCAA-II Central Region Tournament as the number two seed. They will face fifth seeded Winona State (29-13) in the opening round game. The Warriors won their conference tournament to get the automatic bid from the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference.

### Mules fall in MIAA title games

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The Central Missouri Mules needed just one win on Sunday to clinch its eighth straight MIAA Tournament title, but unfortunately the Emporia State Hornets ended that dream sweeping the Mules 8-4 and 7-6 at Crane Stadium.

In the opener, Central Missouri (48-11) trailed 7-1 after the first four innings and were never able to recover as UCM's defense struggled early committing four errors leading to the Hornet runs. The Mules scored single runs in the fourth and fifth before adding two in the seventh but ultimately it was too late as the Hornets held on for the victory to force the second championship game. Kris Webber started for the Mules but wasn't able to make it out of the third inning allowing five runs, two earned, on six hits. Mark Carey went the rest of the way allowing the final three runs on only two hits.

In the championship game it was a repeat of Saturday's game with neither side scoring until the fifth inning. The Mules scored first courtesy of an Iain Dykins two run home run to left after two were retired. Emporia battled back tying the game in the bottom frame on a two run single from Mark McBratney back up the middle. UCM had a chance to regain the lead in the sixth loading the bases with nobody out but were unable to score. Central Missouri retook the lead in the seventh on Dykins second home run of the day and then added another run in the eighth extending the lead to 4-2. ESU tied the game in the bottom of the eighth on Nick Wolfe's two run homer then took the lead on MacBratney's two run single off the glove of a diving Blaine Rutledge in right field.

The Mules bounced back in the ninth to tie the game at 6 all when Josh Paul ripped a two run double

to right center scoring Gered Mochizuki and Brian McBryde with the tying runs, and had the opportunity to regain the lead with two runners in scoring position but Will Feil flew out to center to end the inning. Emporia would win the game in the bottom of the ninth on a solo home run to left field off the bat of Matt Marasco. Marasco's homer was just out of the reach of Jaros who tried to rob the homer and keep the game tied.



### The Coaches

Head Coach **Darin Hendrickson** is in his fourth season with University of Central Missouri baseball program. Named the Mules' 12th head coach in the summer of 2003, Hendrickson has now put his stamp on one of the top baseball teams in NCAA Division II. The 37-year-old native of Granite City, Ill. has compiled a 206-44 record in his fourth season at the helm. He is third on the all-time win list and first in victory percentage (.828).

He has a career NCAA record of 330-96, including his four seasons at Fontbonne, and has had nine players picked in the Major League Draft in his three seasons at Central Missouri.

**Kyle Pooch** is in his fifth season with Winona State and has led them to a 29-13 overall record after winning the NSIC Tournament and grabbing the automatic bid. While at WSU, he has amassed a 139-99-1 overall record.

Hendrickson is 4-1 against Winona State while Pooch is 1-4 against UCM.

### The Series

The Mules lead the Warriors 13-2 in the overall series and have not met them in the NCAA Tournament since the 2000 season when the Mules won by a 13-1 margin. The only other postseason meeting was in 1998 when UCM grabbed a 15-3 decision in the Regional at Crane Stadium. The last loss for the Mules in the series came back in the 2004 regular season when the Warriors took a 4-3 win in Warrensburg.

### Scouting the Warriors

The Warriors come into the game having won their last seven outings. They are led by first-team all-region catcher Ben Barrone, who leads the nation with 26 home runs and boasts a .441 batting average. Starting pitcher Bryan Ruff has a 1.56 earned run average and a 4-2 record while striking out 67 batters in 52 innings.

### Mules Baseball: Winningest Team of the Millenium

The University of Central Missouri baseball program has had unprecedented success in the last 20 years and has been even more impressive since 2000. With the win over ESU Saturday, UCM has a 414-83 overall record since 2000, the most wins of any program in NCAA Division I, II, or III. **The Mules also passed their win total from a year ago and are looking for their eighth 50 win season in school history and seventh in the last eight years.**

### Power Paul

Central Missouri senior first baseman Josh Paul was named the MIAA and Central Region Player of the Year this week. He has hit a team high 18 home runs (the second most for a Mule in a season) and needs only two more to tie the UCM and MIAA record of 20, set by Central Missouri Hall of Famer Ben Slemmer. His 29 career homers also rank fourth in school history, only one behind Slemmer.

### Home Field Dominance

The Mules have won 30 of their last 33 games at Crane Stadium and are 26-3 this season. **Darin Hendrickson has also compiled a 115-14 overall mark at home.**

The Mules have also put up some gaudy numbers on both offense and defense at home. They hit .360 as a team at home and boast a stellar 2.64 ERA. Josh Paul and Seth Gilleland have really been good at Crane Stadium as Paul hits .466 with nine homers and a .955 slugging percentage. Gilleland is 5-0 and has a 1.69 ERA.

### Shut Down Bullpen

The Central Missouri Mules baseball squad has returned to form on the mound after the 2005 Major League Draft took five pitchers. Nine throwers in 2007 have ERA's under 4.0 with the top two combining for an 18-2 record in Gilleland and Potts.

Closer **Bryan Collins** has six saves and a 1.45 ERA while set up man/closer **Chris Radliff** has a 1.00 ERA and three saves along with four wins and was named the MIAA Pitcher of the Week once. They have combined to strike out 76 batters in 58.0 innings.

### Late Inning Defense

The Mules have outscored the opposition overall in every inning this year. Even better, they have virtually shut down their opponents in the seventh, eighth, ninth, and extra innings. The largest gap is in the fourth inning where the Mules have outscored their opponents 76-25. The biggest trouble area has been the first frame as they have allowed 37 and scored 56 in the first.

### National Leaders

The Mules have several players ranked on the national scene in Division II as of May 13. The team ERA of 3.14 ranks 10th in the nation, the strikeouts per game of 8.5 ranks sixth, and the Mules winning percentage of .814 is eighth. As a team, the Mules also rank 12th in home runs per game at 1.24.

Individually, Seth Gilleland is ranked 11th in the nation in wins while Blaine Rutledge is 13th in triples per game at .14. Josh Paul is also eighth in home runs with 18.

### Goin' Streaking!

The Mules have used several team and individual streaks to get to their 48-11 overall record. The longest winning streak of the season was 14 games earlier this year.

Individually, junior Bryan McBryde has had the longest hitting streak of the season at 13 games. Junior Blaine Rutledge had the second longest streak at 12 game while Josh Paul has had a streak of 11. The longest current streak on the squad is Will Feil and Nick Jaros at eight apiece.

### MIAA Hitting

Most teams in college baseball will see their team batting average go down once their team hits conference play, but the Mules have been just the opposite this season. They are hitting 13 points higher in MIAA action at .357 and have

knocked 47 home runs in 34 games.

Josh Paul is .423 and hit 16 of his league leading 18 homers in against conference teams while Iain Dykins has also been better, hitting .400 with 11 of his 13 homers in conference sponsored action. Nearly every player is hitting better in conference action.

### Injury Report

Josh Paul and Will Feil, while starting every game last weekend, will be even more healthy this week after injuries at the end of the conference slate. relief pitcher Matt Michals is the big addition though, as he will be back after sitting out the final three weeks of the season. Chris Brown will be ready to go as well after nursing a hamstring pull two weeks ago. Brandon Morris is out for the season with an elbow injury.

### Mules in the NCAA Tournament

With the success of the Central Missouri baseball program, there are some impressive numbers when it comes to the NCAA Tournament appearances.

UCM is 43-17 all-time in regional games and 20-4 in regionals since 2000. This is the Mules 21st NCAA Regional Appearance and their 14th consecutive year to qualify for the NCAA Tournament.

This is the 12th NCAA Regional held in Warrensburg and the 9th in the last 10 years. The game vs. Winona State is the 108th game in the NCAA Tournament in UCM baseball history (68-39).

UCM baseball has won 13 NCAA Regional Championships in Baseball. UCM has won two national titles (94 and 03) and finished in the top five 11 times and in the top three on seven occasions. The Mules have finished first, second or third in the nation in five of the last six seasons.

With baseball making the regional, 14 of 16 UCM sports qualified for NCAA post-season in 2006-07. Baseball, men's basketball and men's and women's cross country all hosted regional competition this year. UCM is currently ranked sixth in the NACDA Directors Cup Standings.
