The Games:

The ninth ranked Mules (44-8, 26-5 MIAA) go into the final home series with Northwest Missouri (28-22, 21-11 MIAA) having already clinched the MIAA title. The conference tournament will be held at Crane Stadium next weekend. The Mules are in a tight race with Minnesota State-Mankato for the No. 1 seed in the Central Region as that school will host the first round of the regional at its home field.

Mules dominate Lions in four-game sweep

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The University of Central Missouri Mules were all over Missouri Southern from start to finish in a four-game series at Crane Stadium/Tompkins Field, outscoring the Lions 43-3 on the weekend. UCM won by scores of 10-0, 13-0, 8-1, and 12-2 to move their home winning streak to 26 games (22-0 this year).

Mules pitching boasted a 0.90 team ERA on the weekend while the offense dominated with a .434 batting average.

Central Missouri came out strong behind a stellar pitching performance from **Seth Gilleland** (10-1) on Friday night, staking him to a 7-0 lead in five innings of work. He gave up four hits and struck out seven compared to only one walk. On offense, the Mules were paced by a 3-of-4 performance from **Blaine Rutledge**, as he knocked in four RBI. **Will Feil** also racked up a couple RBI on a two-run homer to left center in the third inning. Peter Davenport came in to throw the final three frames to get the save.

On Saturday, the Mules got a solid start from **Kris Webber** (8-1) as he threw five innings in the first game of the doubleheader and allowed only two hits while striking out three. The offense got on the board early and often as it plated two runs in the first and exploded for eight in the third frame. Feil scored four runs in the game and hit his second homer of the weekend to left field in the fifth inning. **Brian McBryde** led the squad with three RBI in the game while **Nick Jaros** chipped in with a 2-of-3 performance and knocked in a couple runs. **Mark Carey** tossed the final two and allowed only two hits.

The nightcap saw MSSU finally get on the board in the third inning but it would only plate one run as

UCM starter **Jarod Potts** (6-2) threw an outstanding six-frame one-hitter while striking out six and walking one. **Bryan Collins** came in for the final inning and walked a couple batters but ended the game on a double play ball to the third baseman.

The Mules scored a run in the first inning and the Lions tied in the third but it wouldn't last long as UCM tallied three runs in the bottom half of the frame thanks to a first pitch homer by **Iain Dykins** to lead it off. The Mules followed that with three more in the fourth and gave Potts an 8-1 lead going into the sixth. Dykins and **Chris Brown** were the stars on offense as they each went 4-of-4 and knocked in a combined five RBI. As a team the Mules pounded out 15 hits. **Gered Mochizuki** also led off the game with a homer to the opposite field.

The final game on Sunday was another hit fest for the Mules as they smacked 17 and scored 12 more runs to end the game after eight. **Ron Martin** (4-2) threw the first five innings of shutout, two-hit baseball before allowing four hits in the sixth frame and a couple runs. **Chris Radliff** came in to shut down the Lions threat though, grabbing the final two outs and cruising through the next frame before **Travis Pyatt** finished it off in the eighth.

The Mules bats were led by Mochizuki and **Luis Perez**, who each had three hits in the game. Jaros scored three runs and crushed a solo shot to left in the second inning to give UCM the lead for good. UCM made the run rule official when **Alex Kent** came in to pinch hit in the eighth and hit a three-run walk-off homer, his first as a Mule.

The Coaches



Head Coach **Darin Hendrickson** is in his fourth season with University of Central Missouri baseball program. Named the Mules' 12th head coach in the summer of 2003, Hendrickson has now put his stamp on one of the top baseball teams in NCAA Division II. The 37-year-old native of Granite City, Ill. has compiled a 202-41 record in his fourth season at the helm. He is third on the all-time win list and first in victory percentage (.831).

He has a career NCAA record of 328-95, including his four seasons at Fontbonne, and has had nine players picked in the Major League Draft in his three seasons at Central Missouri.

Darin Loe is in his eighth season at Northwest Missouri and has compiled a 231-196 record there. As a collegiate head coach, he boasts a 387-330 mark after stints at Baker and Missouri Valley. He led the 2003 Bearcats to a second place finish in the MIAA and a NCAA Tournament berth.

Hendrickson is 10-3 against NWMSU while Loe is 5-22 against UCM.

The Series

The Mules lead the Bearcats by a 114-61 margin, playing them more times than any other school. Last season the Bearcats took three-of-four from the Mules in Maryville but UCM has won eight consecutive games in Warrensburg, dating back to 2003.

Scouting the Bearcats

The Bearcats rank second in the MIAA with a 4.54 ERA and fifth in hitting with a .310 average. Britt and Ryley Westman lead the attack with a .343 average while Brian Lamers and Bret Harvel pace the Bearcats on the mound with 7-2 and 4-4 records, respectively. The offensive attack is a balanced one as they have 11 players hitting more than .300.

Mules Baseball: Winningest Team of the Millenium

The University of Central Missouri baseball program has had unprecedented success in the last 20 years and has been even more impressive since 2000. With the win over MSSU Sunday, UCM has a 410-80 overall record since 2000, the most wins of any program in NCAA Division I, II, or III. The Mules also just matched their win total from a year ago with four games to go in the regular season and postseason tournaments coming up.

Maui Time

Central Missouri leadoff hitter and second baseman **Gered Mochizuki** leads the ninth ranked Mules with a .404 batting average, 74 hits, 60 runs, 18 doubles, 45 walks, 16 stolen bases, and a .528 on-base percentage. He is the only returning All-American and leads the MIAA in total hits, walks, on base percentage, and runs.

Home Field Dominance

The Mules are currently riding a 26-game home winning streak at Crane Stadium and are 22-0 this season. It is the longest current streak in the MIAA and no team in UCM history has ever finished unbeaten in Warrensburg. **Darin Hendrickson has also compiled a 111-11 overall mark at home.**

The Mules have also put up some gaudy numbers on both offense and defense during the streak. They hit .370 as a team at home and boast a stellar 1.97 ERA. Josh Paul and Seth Gilleland have really been good at Crane Stadium as Paul hits .508 with seven homers and a 1.062 slugging percentage. Gilleland is 5-0 and has only been scored on two times with a 0.60 ERA.

On a side note, no team has lost a home game with Shawn Jones as the play-by-play voice since football dropped to second-ranked Northwest Missouri on October 28. Mules athletics have also teamed up for an exciting streak. No Mules team sport has lost a home game since the wrestlers on February 8 to top-ranked Central Oklahoma.

Dirty Rotation

The Central Missouri Mules baseball squad has returned to form on the mound after the 2005 Major League Draft took five pitchers. Nine throwers in 2007 have ERA's under 4.0 with the top two combining for an 18-2 record. Starter **Seth Gilleland** (10-1) has been named MIAA Pitcher of the Week two times while **Kris Webber** (8-1) has been named once. They are ranked one and three in the MIAA in pitching as Webber boasts a 1.87 ERA and Gilleland has 2.21 average.

Closer **Bryan Collins** has five saves and a 0.74 ERA while set up man/closer **Chris Radliff** has a 0.79 ERA and three saves along with four wins and was named the MIAA Pitcher of the Week once. They have combined to hold their opponents to a .122 average this season (19-of-156).

National Leaders

The Mules have several players ranked on the national scene in Division II as of April 30. The team ERA of 2.91 ranks sixth in the nation, the strikeouts per game of 8.8 ranks fourth, and the Mules winning percentage of .846 is fourth.

Individually, Seth Gilleland is ranked fifth in the nation in wins while Blaine Rutledge is fourth in triples per game at .17. Josh Paul is also 10th in home runs with 16.

Late Inning Defense

The Mules have outscored the opposition overall in every inning this year. Even better, they have virtually shut down their opponents in the seventh, eighth, ninth, and extra innings. The largest gap is in the fourth inning where the Mules have outscored their opponents 61-18. The biggest trouble area has been the sixth and first frames as they have allowed 36 runs and scored 54 in the sixth and allowed 34 and scored 51 in the first..

Goin' Streaking!

The Mules have used several team and individual streaks to get to their 44-8 overall record. The longest winning streak of the season was 14 games earlier this year. They are currently on a six game ride.

Individually, junior Bryan McBryde has had the longest hitting streak of the season at 13 games. Junior Blaine Rutledge had the second longest streak at 12 game while Gered Mochizuki and Clay Weatherford each had streaks of 10. The longest current streak on the squad is Josh Paul at nine and Rutledge is at seven.

MIAA Hitting

Most teams in college baseball will see their team batting average go down once their team hits conference play, but the Mules have been just the opposite this season. They are hitting 16 points higher in MIAA action at .361 and have knocked 47 home runs in 31 games.

Josh Paul is .414 and has hit 14 of his league leading 16 homers in conference play while Iain Dykins has also been even better, hitting .401 with nine of his 11 homers in conference action.
