The Game:

The seventh ranked Mules (46-9, 28-6 MIAA) go into the MIAA Postseason Tournament as the number one seed after winning the regular season title. Fourth seeded Fort Hays State (33-18, 21-13 MIAA) comes in also ranked fourth in the region. The Mules are in a tight race with Minnesota State-Mankato for the No. 1 seed in the region as that school will host the Central Regional at its home field.

Mules take two from Bearcats

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The University of Central Missouri Mules took two of three games against the Northwest Missouri State Bearcats this weekend before the final game of the series was cancelled due to rain. The Mules won 6-5 on Friday, and both teams grabbed a 6-2 decision on Saturday.

The Mules knew that they were the MIAA Regular Season Champions before the first game of the series on Friday night, making it their 20th conference title.

Central Missouri (46-9, 28-6 MIAA) fell behind 1-0 in the first game before coming back to take the lead in the second inning on an RBI single from **Chris Joblin** and a sacrifice bunt from **Clay Weatherford**. The Bearcats answered that with four unanswered runs in the fourth and fifth frames though, leaving UCM to battle from behind. The Mules tacked on single runs in the sixth and seventh innings with **Nick Jaros** bringing in **Blaine Rutledge** on a single through the left side to cut the advantage to one at 5-4. The Mules were held scoreless in the bottom of the eighth, but rallied in the ninth frame. It was a sloppy game for UCM as they committed four errors, making only two of the five runs earned. **Seth Gilleland** was responsible for all the runs before **Travis Pyatt** came in to throw 2.2 frames of shutout baseball and move to 3-0 on the year.

Josh Paul came in to pinch hit to lead off the inning after not having an at-bat since the Emporia State series. He came through with a blooper into right field. After advancing to second on a balk, **Gered Mochizuki** moved him to third on a sacrifice bunt. Rutledge tied it on the next at bat with a single up the middle. The Bearcat pitcher tried to pick him off but threw it away and allowed Rutledge to move to third.

NWMSU had no choice but to intentionally walk **Iain Dykins** and Jaros to load the bases. That brought freshman **Alex Kent** to the plate with two outs after **Luis Perez** struck out. He came through for the Mules by beating out a slow chopper toward second base for the game-winner.

The first game on Saturday wasn't quite as dramatic as the Bearcats handed UCM its first home loss of the season. Northwest charted runs in the second and third before the Mules came back to tie it in the fourth. The Bearcats would plate four more runs, only two of which were earned due to another error by the Mules. **Brian Lamers** threw a complete game and allowed only six UCM hits for the win.

The second game of the doubleheader was back on the Mules though as they used a big fourth inning to take control. **Jarod Potts** shut the Bearcats down for the first three innings and allowed only one hit on the day to grab the win. **Bryan Collins** had his longest outing of the season in relief, throwing the final 2.2 innings, and came on with a bases loaded situation to grab the save. Central Missouri came out in the first inning to grab a run before **Bryan McBryde** had a key two-RBI single in the fourth to make it 5-1. McBryde would score in the sixth when Mochizuki drove him in with two outs from second base.

The Coaches



Head Coach **Darin Hendrickson** is in his fourth season with University of Central Missouri baseball program. Named the Mules' 12th head coach in the summer of 2003, Hendrickson has now put his stamp on one of the top baseball teams in NCAA Division II. The 37-year-old native of Granite City, Ill. has compiled a 204-42 record in his fourth season at the helm. He is third on the all-time win list and first in victory percentage (.828).

He has a career NCAA record of 330-96, including his four seasons at Fontbonne, and has had nine players picked in the Major League Draft in his three seasons at Central Missouri.

Rick Sabath is in his first season as head coach at Fort Hays after serving last season as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for the University of Kansas. He has been the head coach at both Cloud County and Garden City Community Colleges from 2000-05. A 1994 graduate of FHSU, he earned his masters in 1996 from Kansas. Hendrickson is 4-1 against Fort Hays State while Sabath is 1-2 against UCM.

The Series

The Mules lead the Tigers 9-2 in the overall series and won the season clip by taking 2-of-3 this year. The Mules have not lost to FHSU in Warrensburg since 1996 and are 5-1 at Crane Stadium all-time. UCM outscored the Tigers 28-16 in the three game series at Larks Park.

Scouting the Tigers

Fort Hays State comes into the game with a 33-18 overall mark and are led by designated hitter Dusty Washburn with a .362 average and 21 doubles. As a team the Tigers hit .310 and have an ERA of 5.47 to put them at fifth in the MIAA. Closer Tyler Nuss leads the MIAA in saves with nine while boasting a 3.99 ERA. Tom Goodwin leads the squad in wins with an 8-2 mark while number one starter Justin Randa paces the squad with a 2.25 ERA and a 7-2 record.

Mules Baseball: Winningest Team of the Millenium

The University of Central Missouri baseball program has had unprecedented success in the last 20 years and has been even more impressive since 2000. With the win over NWMSU Saturday, UCM has a 412-81 overall record since 2000, the most wins of any program in NCAA Division I, II, or III. The Mules also passed their win total from a year ago with postseason tournaments coming up.

Maui Time

Central Missouri leadoff hitter and second baseman **Gered Mochizuki** leads the ninth ranked Mules with a .400 batting average, 78 hits, 60 runs, 19 doubles, 45 walks, 16 stolen bases, and a .519 on-base percentage. He is the only returning All-American and leads the MIAA in total hits, walks, and on base percentage.

Home Field Dominance

The Mules have won 28 of their last 29 games at Crane Stadium and are 24-1 this season. **Darin Hendrickson has also compiled a 113-12 overall mark at home.**

The Mules have also put up some gaudy numbers on both offense and defense at home. They hit .364 as a team at home and boast a stellar 2.10 ERA. Josh Paul and Seth

Gilleland have really been good at Crane Stadium as Paul hits .514 with seven homers and a 1.029 slugging percentage. Gilleland is 5-0 and has only been scored on four times with a 0.99 ERA.

On a side note, no team has lost a home game with Shawn Jones as the play-by-play voice since football dropped to second-ranked Northwest Missouri on October 28.

Dirty Rotation

The Central Missouri Mules baseball squad has returned to form on the mound after the 2005 Major League Draft took five pitchers. Nine throwers in 2007 have ERA's under 4.0 with the top two combining for an 18-3 record. Starter **Seth Gilleland** (10-1) has been named MIAA Pitcher of the Week two times while **Kris Webber** (8-2) has been named once. They are ranked two and four in the MIAA in pitching as Webber boasts a 2.23 ERA and Gilleland has 2.26 average.

Closer **Bryan Collins** has six saves and a 1.00 ERA while set up man/closer **Chris Radliff** has a 0.77 ERA and three saves along with four wins and was named the MIAA Pitcher of the Week once. They have combined to hold their opponents to a .130 average this season (22-of-169).

Late Inning Defense

The Mules have outscored the opposition overall in every inning this year. Even better, they have virtually shut down their opponents in the seventh, eighth, ninth, and extra innings. The largest gap is in the fourth inning where the Mules have outscored their opponents 72-21. The biggest trouble area has been the sixth and first frames as they have allowed 41 runs and scored 58 in the sixth and allowed 35 and scored 56 in the first.

National Leaders

The Mules have several players ranked on the national scene in Division II as of April 30. The team ERA of 2.92 ranks sixth in the nation, the strikeouts per game of 8.6 ranks sixth, and the Mules winning percentage of .836 is fifth.

Individually, Seth Gilleland is ranked eighth in the nation in wins while Blaine Rutledge is fourth in triples per game at .16. Josh Paul is also 10th in home runs with 16.

Goin' Streaking!

The Mules have used several team and individual streaks to get to their 46-9 overall record. The longest winning streak of the season was 14 games earlier this year. They had a seven game streak snapped on Saturday.

Individually, junior Bryan McBryde has had the longest hitting streak of the season at 13 games. Junior Blaine Rutledge had the second longest streak at 12 game while Josh Paul has had a streak of 11. The longest current streak on the squad is Blaine Rutledge at 10.

MIAA Hitting

Most teams in college baseball will see their team batting average go down once their team hits conference play, but the Mules have been just the opposite this season. They are hitting 13 points higher in MIAA action at .357 and have knocked 47 home runs in 34 games.

Josh Paul is .423 and has hit 14 of his league leading 16 homers in conference play while Iain Dykins has also been better, hitting .400 with nine of his 11 homers in conference action. Nearly every player is hitting better in conference action.

Injury Report

The Mules will have Josh Paul and Will Feil back in a starting capacity this weekend while Chris Brown will be out with a pulled leg muscle. The other injuries are to the pitching staff. Matt Michals is still uncertain with a strain in his elbow while Brandon Morris is out for the season with an elbow injury.
