CMSU Jennies sign two in early signing period

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The 2002-03 basketball season is only six games old, and Central Missouri State University Jennies basketball coach **Scott Ballard** is already ahead of the competition in preparing for next year's campaign, as he has signed a pair of prep athletes during the NCAA women's basketball early signing period.

Joining the Jennies for the 2003-04 season are **Meagan Fromm** and **Ashley Millham**, seniors at Scotland County High School in Memphis, Mo., and Notre Dame High School in Cape Girardeau, Mo., respectively.

Fromm, a 5-11 guard/forward, has earned all-conference honors following her freshman, sophomore, and junior seasons at Sotland County, and was named conference Most Valuable Player the past two years. Coached by Andrea Dabney, Fromm was also an all-district pick each of the past three seasons, and was tabbed second-team all-state as a junior last year. The daughter of Kevin and Dani Fromm, she is also a softball player at Scotland County High.

Millham is the daughter of Craig and Carla Millham, and the younger sister of Jennies freshman guard Lisa Millham. A 5-11 guard, she earned all-conference and all-district honors on the hardwood as a sophomore and junior at Notre Dame, and has lettered all three seasons. Last season Millham helped lead coach Jerry Grim's squad to the state title after a runner-up finish in 2001. She also has lettered twice in volleyball and once in track & field.

The Jennies, 3-3 this season, open play in the Holiday Inn Express Jennies Tournament tonight at 7:30 when they play Lincoln University. Game one of the tournament will pit the University of Minnesota-Morris against the University of Nebraska-Omaha at 5:30 p.m. The consolation game of the tournament will be tomorrow evening at 5:30, with the championship game slated to tip off at 7:30 p.m.
