### Mules roll in season opener, 81-53

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – Zack Wright set the tone for the Central Missouri Mules with a three pointer on the first possession and stellar defense all night long against the Fighting Scots of Monmouth College to grab an 81-53 season-opening win.

Central Missouri (1-0) coasted to a 49-22 halftime lead and held MC to 31 percent from the floor while hitting a blistering 52 percent. Wright tallied 13 first half points while Darryl Sommerset chipped in with 10. All phases were clicking for UCM as they also held a 26-13 rebound advantage at the break.

The Mules blew the game wide open in first part of the second stanza though. By the 12:21 mark they had moved the lead to a game-high 42 points (69-27). Central Missouri did it the old fashioned way too, with defense and rebounding. The Mules had a 44-to-27 rebound margin and had 10 steals on the night. They also hit more than 50 percent on the night due to 48 points in the paint. Several easy lay-ups in transition also contributed to the percentage. Every player that UCM suited up got in the game and the Mules had 27 points off the bench.

Wright finished the night with 16 points while Alonzo Brooks put up 15 and Sommerset tallied 14. Wadale Williams had seven assists on the night while Charles Stoker grabbed a team-high nine rebounds. Monmouth was led by Joe Terwelp with 24 points and nine rebounds.



### The Coaches

In his fifth season at the University of Central Missouri, Kim Anderson has moved into elite company. He has led the Mules to an 80-40 overall record and is only the second coach in school history to win 24 games in back-to-back seasons (Jim Wooldridge being the other). During the past three seasons, the Mules are also the winningest team in MIAA play, posting 35 victories.

Last season, he guided the Mules to their first NCAA Tournament win since 1996 and posted a 24-8 overall record and a second-place finish in the MIAA (11-5). He also coached the eighth All-American in UCM history, Michael Hicks. With the signing of a contract with ALM Evreux (France) this summer, Hicks became the first Mule to play professionally since 1995 (Armando Becker).

In 2004-05 he led the Mules to a record of 24-7, a share of their first MIAA regular season title since 1984-85, and UCM's first men's MIAA Tournament Championship since 1983-84. For his effort, Anderson was named Wilson/MIAA Coach of the Year.
