Mules and Jennies fair well at PSU

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The Central Missouri State track and field squads competed in the Pittsburg State University Quadrangular over the weekend and had some solid individual performances. The Jennies had 26 top five finishes and six event titles while the Mules went for 24 top five's and seven first place marks.

For the Jennies, **Becky Haug** won the discus with a throw of 147-10, giving her a provisional mark for the NCAA Championships, **Elise Johnson** won the 100 meters with a time of 12.17 seconds, **Amber Walker** won the 200 meter dash in 24.93 seconds, **Lori Pitz** achieved a provisional mark winning the 400 meter hurdles with a mark of 1:02.91. The 4x100 Relay team won with a time of 48.34 and the 4x400 Relay team defeated their next closest competitor by nearly seven seconds winning in 3:57.95.

For the Mules, **Dan Raithe** won the hammer throw with a toss of 189-06 gaining a provisional mark, **Steven Edwards** won the discus with a throw of 163-05, **Matt Prescott**, won the 110 Meter hurdles with a time of 14.78 seconds, **Bruce Williams**, sprinted past the competition winning the 100 meters in 10.69 seconds, and the 200 meters in 21.03 seconds, gaining a provisional time. **Jacob Palmer** won the 400 meter hurdles with a time of 53.73 and **Tommy Neal** took the 5000 meters with a time of 15:06.35.

The Mules and Jennies will be back in action this weekend when they travel to Emporia, Kan. to take part in the Emporia State Multi Events on Thursday and Friday, and then will take part in the Division II Challenge on Saturday.
