

## **JENNIES VOLLEYBALL TEAM LOOKS TO CONTINUE MIAA STREAK**

**WARRENSBURG, MO (September 18, 2001)** -- Enjoying a current six-match winning streak that has boosted its record to 10-3, Central Missouri State's women's volleyball team will try to extend its MIAA winning streak this week. The Jennies, 3-0 in MIAA matches and ranked 18<sup>th</sup> in this week's AVCA Division II poll, entertain Emporia State (7-6, 2-0 MIAA) Wednesday night at 7 p.m. at the CMSU Multipurpose Building. Following Wednesday night's match, the Jennies will be on the road for three straight matches, playing at Missouri Western Friday night at 7 p.m., at Northwest Missouri Saturday at 5:30 p.m., and at Washburn next Wednesday (Sept. 26) at 7 p.m.

Wednesday night's match with Emporia State will bring together two coaches with a combined total of 1,424 career coaching wins. Jennies' coach Peggy Martin leads Division II with 851 career coaching wins, while Emporia State's Maxine Mehus is fifth in career wins with 573. The Jennies' all-time record against Emporia State is 28-1 and they have won 21 straight against the Hornets. The last win by the Hornets in the series was in 1991. Against Missouri Western, the Jennies are 51-2; against Northwest Missouri, they are 58-6 and against Washburn, they are 31-1.

Senior **Janell Mohme** earned the MIAA hitter of the week award for her performance in the Jennies' three wins last week. She hit .408 with 40 kills in the three matches and also had 13 kills to move into third place on the Jennies' career blocks list with 559. For the season, Mohme is hitting .313 with a team-leading 65 blocks. **Carrie Potthast** leads the Jennies in kills with 197 and in digs with 138.
