

Mules Place 19th at NCAA Div. II Wrestling Championships

Central Missouri State had two all-Americans and scored 18 points to finish 19th at the NCAA Div. II Championships in Kenosha, Wis., Saturday. Central Oklahoma won the team title.

Earning all-America honors for the Mules were seniors **Luke Shaw** (5th at 133) and **John Rolling** (7th at 184). The Mules' four other qualifiers -- Drew Passley at 141, Eric Pizzi at 149, Jared Lien at 157 and Willie McCowan at heavyweight -- were eliminated before reaching the placement rounds.

Shaw earned his second all-America honor (he was fourth at 133 in 2000), while Rolling earned his second all-America award as well (he was fourth at 184 last season). Shaw, who won his final match with a 4-2 decision, was 29-16 this season and finished his CMSU career with a record of 118-49 (.706). His 118 career wins are third-best in Mules' history. Rolling, who won his final match with a 3-2 decision, was 17-13 this season and finished with a career record of 102-59 (.634). He became just the fourth wrestler in Mules' history with 100 or more career wins.
