### The Games:

The 20th ranked Mules (13-5, 3-1 MIAA) go into their first four game MIAA series this Thursday and Friday against Washburn. Central Missouri comes into the games after a split with Northwest last Friday while the Ichabods took three of four from Southwest Baptist last weekend.

### Mules split twinbill with Bearcats

(Maryville, Mo.) – The Central Missouri Mules split an MIAA doubleheader on Friday against the Northwest Missouri Bearcats in Maryville, dropping game one by a 6-5 margin in 12 innings before grabbing a 5-3 win in the nightcap.

Danny Potje started game one a little rough for Central Missouri (13-5, 3-1 MIAA), giving up two runs in the first frame and three unearned scores in the second. He settled down after that though, and tossed two scoreless frames.

The Mules bats came alive from the third inning on, knocking out 14 hits. They tied the game after scoring three in the fifth and two in the sixth inning. Junior Will Feil hit a two RBI single to get UCM on the board before junior Mike Hallam knocked him in on the next at-bat. The Bearcat (9-4, 1-1 MIAA) left fielder saved a couple runs when he ended the frame by throwing out Hallam at home a couple batters later.

Chris Matlock came into the game in the fifth, and threw more innings than Potje. He tossed 7.0 innings of shutout baseball, allowing only four hits, but the Bearcats scored an unearned game-winner in the bottom of the 12th to get the win. NWMSU reliever Evan Nickell was just as good in relief, throwing 6.2 innings of shutout baseball, allowing only three hits.

The game two star for Central Missouri was junior starter Mark Carey. He was one out away from a complete game, tossing 6.2 innings while striking out nine and allowing only four hits. All three of the runs

he gave up came in the fourth inning.

Central Missouri scored runs in the first, second, and fourth innings, including a solo homer in the second by Jayson Brugman. The Bearcats tied the game in the fourth before the Mules saved it from going to extra innings with a couple runs in the top of the seventh. Balin Bergman got it started with a double to the right center gap. Brian McBryde laid down a sacrifice bunt but the Bearcats tried to get the man at third and reached safely. Luis Perez got the big hit on the next at-bat, knocking in one run and advancing McBryde to second on a single up the middle. Blaine Rutledge advanced the runners on a sacrifice bunt before Clay Weatherford had a sacrifice fly to right, scoring McBryde.

Carey got the first two batters in the bottom of the seventh before Alex Kent came in for the save, throwing one pitch and getting a ground out.

## The Coaches



Head Coach **Tom Myers** is coaching his first season at Central Missouri after a four-year stay at Kansas State University as the hitting and outfielders coach.

He also coach three seasons at UCM, including the 2003 National Championship and 2001 runner-up. During his time with the Mules, they had an outstanding record of 154-30.

As the head coach, he is 13-5 overall but during his time as a Mule, he has compiled a 167-35 record (.827).

**Steve Anson** is in his 29th season at Washburn and has compiled a 702-615-3 record there. As a collegiate head coach, he boasts a 725-637-3 mark after one season at Wayne State (Neb.). He is a member of the All-Century Team at Kansas State, where he played from 1973-76. He won the Big 8 batting title in 1974 as well.

Myers is 0-0 against WU while Anson is 14-54 against UCM.

## The Series

The Mules lead the Ichabods by a 54-14 margin, winning 20 of the last 21 games in the series. Last season Central Missouri took 3-of-4 and outscored the Ichabods 24-9.

Central Missouri has not lost to Washburn at home since 2001. The Mules and Ichabods have actually not played at Crane Stadium since 2005.

## Scouting the Ichabods

The Ichabods come in with a 5-5 overall record after taking three of four from Southwest Baptist in their MIAA opening series.

Freshman Cameron Kasel leads the team in hitting with a .429 average and eight RBI while junior Brian Gorges ranks second with a .381 mark, but leads the team with four homers. As a team the 'Bods hit .282 and have scored 57 runs in 10 games (5.7 per game).

On the pitching side of things, right-hander Brett Sorensen is 2-0 with a 0.60 ERA and 13 strikeouts in 15 frames. Senior Zach Engelken is 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA and both Danny Cook and Bryan Stroth are 1-1 with 8.44 and 9.53 ERA's. All four of those probable starters are right-handed. Lefty Curtis Hamilton has started once but comes out of the bullpen to post a 1-0 mark with a 1.59 ERA. Righty Andrew Miller leads the team in appearances with four and has one save with a 2.70 ERA.

## Mules Baseball: Winningest Team of the Millenium

The University of Central Missouri baseball program has had unprecedented success in the last 20 years and has been even more impressive since 2000. UCM has a 430-89 overall record since 2000, the most wins of any program in NCAA Division I, II, or III.

## B-Mac Record Watch

Central Missouri senior shortstop **Bryan McBryde** has been a four-year starter and is closing in on several career records. He is currently only 34 hits away from tying UCM Hall of Famer Craig Ringe (275) as the all-time leader in Central Missouri and MIAA history. He is also 11 doubles away from that career mark, also held by Ringe (61). McBryde is 109 assists away from Ringe's career mark (583) as well.

## Home Field Dominance

The Mules are 6-0 so far this season at Crane Stadium/Tompkins Field. They have been dominant over the years at this site, going 583-109-1 (.841). Since 1993, Central Missouri has not lost more than five games in a season in Warrensburg and boasts a 365-42 mark (.900).

### *On the Road in the Non-Con*

The Mules can boast a very tough non-conference schedule this season, playing their first 10 games on the road, all against Division II competition. They came out of the stretch at 6-4 after losing the first three games.

New to this season is the in-region competition change, a rule that says any team you play in your state or a bordering state is considered an "in-region" game. Last season, the only games that counted as "in-region" were MIAA, North Central, and Northern Sun conference teams. Now both count, making every game the Mules have played an "in-region" opponent.

### *Hitting with Hallam*

Junior **Mike Hallam** has been the biggest offensive threat for the Mules so far this season, hitting .523 with a team leading 23 hits, eight doubles, and 17 RBI. He also boasts a .955 slugging percentage and is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak. Hallam has also scored a team-high 18 runs and a team-low two strike-outs.

### *Weather-ing the Storm*

Senior center fielder **Clay Weatherford** ranked ninth on the team in batting average last season at .314 but has started this year in suprising fashion, hitting .462 to rank second on the squad. His 17 RBI ranks second on the team and his 24 hits is best on the squad.

### *Closin 'em Out*

The Mules are 13-1 this season when being tied or having the lead after the sixth inning. They have also out-scored their opponent in every inning except the second and third frames.

This has a lot to do with the Central Missouri bullpen. Alex Kent, Nick Phillips, and Chris Matlock have been the three with the most appearances and have combined for four saves with only eight earned runs in 35.0 innings.

### *Rankings and more Rankings*

The Mules are ranked No. 20 in the nation this week in the Collegiate Baseball Magazine Division II poll. There are several different rankings though as the Mules are 15th in the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Division II poll. The NCBWA also comes out with a regional poll each week, and the Mules are currently No. 2 in the Central region.

The only poll that actually matters is the NCAA Regional poll, which comes out in mid-April and will continue to be released every Wednesday until the six-team regional field is announced.
