Central Missouri will try to exact revenge on Southwest Baptist this Tuesday at Crane Stadium /Tompkins Field with a 2:00 p.m. doubleheader. The Mules need to win both games to take the season series, after splitting in Bolivar on March 30.

### No. 2 Mules take first three, drop finale to Tigers

(Warrensburg, Mo.) – The No. 2 University of Central Missouri baseball Mules rolled in the first three contests of a four-game MIAA series against Fort Hays State 20-2, 7-2, and 12-5, but fell in the finale by a 5-2 margin on Sunday.

The Mules (34-5, 26-4 MIAA) used a 12-run sixth inning in the opener on Friday night to ice an 8-2 lead. Fort Hays State (23-14, 16-13 MIAA) scored their first two runs in the first inning though, taking advantage of a Mule error. UCM starter Brooks Martin settled down from there though, tossing six innings and giving up only four hits with 11 strikeouts to move to a league-leading 8-0.

The Mules generated 13 hits, but took advantage of nine walks and four hit-by-pitches to tally their highest run total of the season. Junior third baseman Frank Specht was 2-of-3 with five RBI, junior catcher Eric Cole was 2-of-4 with four RBI, and senior Chance Tuttle had three RBI. Junior first baseman Nick DeBiasse scored a season-high five runs in the game.

The Mules got a two-homer game from Tuttle in the second game of the series, leading off the senior day celebration with a homer, and helping his team come from behind to take a 3-2 lead in the third inning with a two-run shot. The Mules would score one more in the frame to make it a two-run lead on an FHSU error.

Matt Curtis gave up seven Tiger hits in the start, but only allowed two runs in five innings to grab his seventh win of the season. Central Missouri put three insurance runs up in the sixth, thanks to a solo homer from junior right fielder Tyler Ruch, followed by Jon Wegener scoring on a wild pitch and Albert Selanders scoring on a sacrifice fly.

The nightcap on Saturday saw the Mules score early and often. They tallied all 12 runs in the first three innings, including Tuttle's third homer of the day in the third inning to make it 9-1. The Mules had 13 hits in the game, and also got a bomb from Specht, his third of the year. Tuttle finished the game 3-of-4 while three other Mules had two hits.

Senior Mitch Stubenhofer got his second win of the season in the start, going 5.1 innings and giving up five hits and three runs with four strikeouts.

The series finale was a pitching dual on Sunday, as senior right-hander Ryan Allen tossed the first five innings of perfect baseball before giving up three hits and two runs in the sixth. His counterpart, lefty Matt Augustine gave up two runs in the first two innings, but shut the Mules down the rest of the day. He gave up only five hits, although several were hit hard at defenders. FHSU scored three runs to break the 2-2 tie in the sixth though, and take the win.

## The Coaches



Head Coach **Tom Myers** is in his third season as the head man at Central Missouri, and boasts a 125-37 overall mark.

He didn't take long to continue the UCM tradition either, winning the Central Region title and taking the Mules to their 14th Division II World Series appearance in his first year. They went 47-17 overall and made it to the national semifinals, finishing in 4th place. For his efforts he was named the NABC Central Region Coach of the Year. He also helped the Mules win the MIAA Tournament crown in 2008.

Last season he led the Mules to a 44-15 mark and the No. 1 seed in the NCAA South Central Regional as the host site, and made it to the regional title game.

**Sam Berg** is in his 11th season with Southwest Baptist University and served as an assistant coach at Central Missouri. He was a coach on the staff that won the 1994 National Championship. Berg led SBU to a 9-41 record last season, going 7-31 in the MIAA for 10th. He is 159-373-1 overall at SBU.

Myers is 8-2 against the Bearcats while Berg is 3-39 against UCM.

## The Series

The Mules lead SBU 80-8-1 in the series but dropped a controversial decision at SBU earlier this year. UCM has lost to SBU only three times since 1989, once in 2008, once in 2006, and once this year. All three losses came in Bolivar. The Mules have never lost to SBU in Warrensburg.

## Scouting the Bearcats

The Bearcats come in with an 11-33 overall record after defeating Truman 3-of-4 this weekend. They are 9-25 in MIAA play.

As a team they hit .279 with three regular starters hitting better than .320. Paden Grubbs leads the offense with 37 RBI, 15 doubles, and 11 home runs. Nigel Morton leads the squad in average at .358.

On the mound the Bearcats have a 7.91 ERA and an opponents batting average of .336. Every starter threw innings this weekend against TSU, so the rotation will be TBA against UCM.

## Mules Baseball: Winningest Team of the Millenium

The University of Central Missouri baseball program has had unprecedented success in the last 20 years and has been even more impressive since 2000. UCM has a 542-121 overall record since 2000, the most wins of any program in NCAA Division I, II, or III. **That is an average of 50.8 wins per season during the last 10 seasons.**

## DeBo's for Real

Junior first baseman **Nick DeBiase** leads the Mules in batting average (.437), hits (59), home runs (11), and slugging percentage (.822). He has been named MIAA Hitter of the Week two times and ranks among the MIAA leaders in nearly every offensive statistical category.

### We're Number 2!

The Mules have been ranked in the CBN top 25 for 27 consecutive weeks after their No. 2 ranking earlier this week. This is the highest ranking for the Mules since February 6, 2006. That week they were No. 1 in the nation, tied with Delta State.

Regionally, the Mules are No. 1 in the first NCAA South Central Region poll (page 4). That poll determines who makes the NCAA Tournament, and the top seed serves as the host site.

### Winning 30

Central Missouri has won at least 30 games in 17 consecutive seasons after the series against Washburn. The last time they did not reach the 30-win plateau was in 1993. The Mules have won at least 39 games in each of those seasons as well. The 40-win bench mark has been reached in the last 11 seasons.

UCM's 34-5 record is the best five-loss start since the 2005 team piled up a 41-5 mark before losing their sixth game.

### Middle Impact

The Mules middle of the order hitters have added a power factor to the lineup this season. **Nick DeBiasse**, **Frank Specht**, **Tyler Ruch** and **Jon Wegener** have combined for 29 homers, 46 doubles, six triples, and 169 RBI. The home run total is more than five other teams in the league.

DeBiasse leads the quartet with a .437 average and 48 RBI, while Ruch has 44 RBI. Wegener and Specht have 36 and 41 RBI, respectively. Last season at this point, the Mules had three 30+ RBI guys. This season, six players top that total.

### Out of the Pen

Senior righthander **Alex Kent** leads the way for the Mules bullpen with 16 appearances and 35.1 innings pitched. He has a 6-0 record with a 1.10 ERA on the year.

Also on the back end is closer **Nick Phillips**, who is second in the MIAA in saves at six. He has struck out 18 in 15 innings pitched.

The Mules are 30-1 when leading after the sixth inning.

### Major Rotation

UCM is currently boasting a four-man starting rotation with a 22-1 record and ERA's under 4.00. Brooks Martin has an 8-0 record with a 1.39 ERA, Mitch Stubenhofer is 2-0 with a 2.62 ERA, and Matt Curtis is 7-0 with a 2.93 ERA. Senior Ryan Allen posts a 5-1 mark with a 3.21 ERA.

### Mules Among the Nation

Central Missouri's winning percentage of .882 ranks second in the nation, just behind the Muleriders of Southern Arkansas (.921) coming into the week. The Mules also rank No. 5 in the nation with an ERA of 3.07 and sixth with a fielding percentage of .972. They are in the national top 25 in nine statistical categories, including hits allowed, slugging percentage, and home runs per game.

Individually, Chance Tuttle is 14th in runs scored per game at 1.5. Nick DeBiasse is 12th in slugging percentage at .867 and 19th in on-base percentage at .553, while Brooks Martin is ninth in ERA (1.39), 10th in strikeouts per nine innings (11.82), and 14th in victories (8).

# UCM Head Coach Tom Myers



The University of Central Missouri baseball program reached back into its championship past to hire the 13th head coach in school history as Tom Myers topped a field of more than 100 applicants in the summer of 2007. Now in his third season, the former Mules assistant boasts a 125-37 overall record.

He didn't take long to continue that tradition, **winning the Central Region title and taking the Mules to their 14th Division II World Series appearance in his first season. They went 47-17 overall and made it to the national semifinals, finishing in 4th place. For his efforts he was named the NABC Central Region Coach of the Year.**

**In 2009 he led the Mules to the No. 1 seed and host of the NCAA South Central Regional with a 44-15 mark after returning only one position starter from the year before. He coached the second ABCA National Pitcher of the Year in school history, Chris Matlock, that season as well.**

He also coached two Mules that went to the professional ranks in pitcher Jared Potts, who signed with the Toronto Blue Jays organization, and Matlock, who was drafted by the Texas Rangers in the 23rd round of the 2009 Major League Draft.

Myers spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Kansas State University and before that, three seasons as an assistant coach at Central Missouri, including the 2003 Division II National Championship season.

During Myers first three years at UCM, the Mules went an outstanding 154-30 with a national runner-up and a championship.

At Kansas State under former Mules head coach Brad Hill, Myers was the hitting and outfielders coach and steadily transformed the Wildcat offense into one of the best units in the Big XII Conference.

In 2007, the Wildcats advanced to the post-season for the second time in school history with an appearance in the Big XII Tournament in Oklahoma City. KSU outfielder Byron Wiley was named Second-Team All-Big 12.

In 2006, K-State hit a Big 12-best .314 as a team overall, which included the Big 12 overall hitting leader in outfielder Joe Roundy (.389). The Wildcats boasted four of the Big 12's top 20 hitters in Roundy, outfielder Barrett Rice (.368), catcher Brandon Farr (.337) and third baseman Jared Goedert (.337). Goedert was also selected in the 12th round of the MLB Draft by the Cleveland Indians and had a solid rookie campaign.

In 2005, Myers led a Wildcat offense that hit .309 on the season, a number that was up an incredible 50 points from 2004 and was the sixth-best average in school history. In his first season at K-State, Myers guided Wildcat outfielders Steve Murphy and Terry Blunt to All-Big 12 honors as both were among the league's top offensive players in 2004. Murphy led the 'Cats with a .338 average while Blunt hit .305. Five Wildcat hitters coached by Myers signed professional contracts while at Kansas State. Under Myers, the Wildcats broke into the top 10 in the single-season school record books in seven different offensive categories including home runs, doubles, hits, runs, RBI's, slugging and batting average.

He previously served as assistant under Hill from 2000-01 before returning to his alma mater, Pittsburg State, for one season. During Myers' first go-around at Central Missouri, the Mules posted an incredible .836 winning percentage with three consecutive 50-win seasons, three MIAA crowns and three trips to the Division II Baseball Championships. In addition, UCM led the league in batting average each of those three seasons.

In 2003, Central Missouri captured its second national championship and first since 1994 with an 11-4 victory over the University of Tampa at Paterson Field in Montgomery, Ala. The Mules led the MIAA in nearly every offensive category in 2003, including scoring (9.53 runs per game), hits (602), RBIs (423), doubles (134), home runs (61) and batting average (.364). Six players ranked among the league's top 11 in hitting, including batting leader Joe Strada, who also led in slugging percentage, doubles and RBIs. Myers helped coach two second team All-Americans in 2003 with Strada and third baseman Zach Norman along with six All-MIAA selections. Norman was named the conference's Player of the Year, while outfielder Steve Murphy was the Freshman of the Year.

Myers helped guide Central Missouri to a combined 103 wins in 2000 and

2001. The 2001 squad posted a then school-record 53 wins en route to advancing to its first championship game in seven years where the Mules lost to St. Mary's of Texas by a score of 11-3. During the record-setting campaign, Myers helped coach first baseman Chris Umphres, the 2001 NCAA Division II Player of the Year, who ranked among the nation's leaders in batting average (.448) and RBIs (1.44 per game).

**After his second season as head coach, Myers has now helped coach one NCAA Division II Player of the Year, one National Pitcher of the Year, three first team All-Americans, seven second or third team All-Americans and 16 first team All-MIAA selections during his time at Central Missouri.**

Myers spent the 2002 season as the hitting and outfielders coach at Pittsburg State in Pittsburg, Kan. Under his direction, the Gorillas finished second in the league in home runs, RBIs and extra-base hits, third in runs scored and fifth in batting average.

A native of Bartlesville, Okla., Myers was a first team All-MIAA and All-Central Region selection as a senior at Pittsburg State in 1998. He batted .405 with 72 runs scored, 14 home runs and 59 RBIs that season. Myers was an honorable mention All-MIAA performer as a junior in 1997. He earned his bachelor's degree in management from Pittsburg State in 1999, while serving as a student assistant coach for the Gorillas.

In addition to his duties with the Mule baseball team, Myers also worked in the UCM Office of Development and Alumni Relations. He is married to the

former Tiffany Beshore, who played basketball at Pittsburg State from 1997-98. Myers earned his master's degree in sports and business administration from Central Missouri in 2001. The couple has two children, Logan, 5, and Addison, 3.
