Mules 2008 In Review

The 2008 Mules football team was one win away from making the NCAA Playoffs, going 7-4 and falling in the final minute of two games late in the year. UCM faced five teams that appeared in the post-season, giving them one of the top-five toughest schedules in the nation.

Central Missouri was ranked in seven polls during the season, and in the regional rankings until the final week of the year.

The Mules started the year 4-0 for the first time since 2003, and did it through one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation. They opened the season with a lightning-delayed 29-9 win over an NCAA-II Playoff team in Minnesota State, before handling Arkansas Tech out of the powerful Gulf South Conference by a 49-13 score in a Thursday night affair at Walton Stadium/Kennedy Field.

They opened the MIAA schedule in dramatic fashion with a 31-28 win over Truman State the next week, thanks to a returned interception for a TD by LaVance Dotson. UCM outscored No. 25 Washburn 43-34 in week four as Bobby Guillory scampered in the endzone on two long runs in the fourth quarter.

The winning came to an end the next week though against No. 7 Pittsburg State with a 49-28 setback on the road. UCM bounced back with a 42-14 win over Emporia State before dropping a 20-13 decision to national runner-up Northwest Missouri in week seven.

A dominating 47-14 win at Missouri Southern put the Mules back on track in the hunt for a playoff spot with three games to go, but a heartbreaking loss to play-off bound Nebraska-Omaha in the final minute on Homecoming slimmed their chances. They still had a shot the next week to make it with a win over Mineral Water Bowl participant Missouri Western, but a field goal with six seconds remaining handed the Mules a 42-41 loss.

The Mules finished 5-4 in MIAA play to tie for fourth place after ending the year with a 24-21 win over Fort Hays State. Quarterback Eric Czerniewski threw for

a career-high 371 yards, and had 403 total yards of offense in the contest, the second-highest total in school history for a game.

Individually, Czerniewski had an outstanding season, throwing for a school record 2,938 yards and 27 TD's compared to only 6 INT's. He was a regional finalist for the Harlon Hill Trophy, while sophomore DeMarco Cosby had a tight end record 623 yards receiving and 5 TD's, earning All-American honors.

11 Mules received postseason recognition for their efforts on the field. Cosby, along with senior defensive end John Wood, senior defensive back Steven Ehase, and wide receiver Tim Richmond were named to the All-MIAA first team.

Second team all-league honors went to senior running back Glenn Milner. Honorable mention honors went to Czerniewski, along with senior kicker Mark Starks, junior kick returner Bobby Guillory, senior linebacker Adrian Singletary, senior defensive tackle Derek Lampkin, and junior punter Jordan Hofer.

After the season Wood was honored by earning an invitation from the Cactus Bowl to play in the Division II All-Star Game in Kingsville, Texas.

The Mules also did the job in the classroom. 40 student-athletes were named to the MIAA Academic Honor Roll.

Last Time They Met - October 27, 2007

(Boivar, Mo.) – The University of Central Missouri Mules scored the game's first 28 points and coasted to a 56-14 victory over the winless Southwest Baptist Bearcats on Saturday, October 27 at Plaster Stadium.

The Mules (6-3, 5-2 MIAA) moved into a four-way tie for second place in the MIAA with the win. They were led on the day by three different quarterbacks as they combined for 327 yards passing and three touchdowns.

Eric Czerniewski got the Mules started on the first possession of the game as he connected with Tim Richmond from 37 yards out for a 7-0 lead. The Bearcats (0-9, 0-7 MIAA) tried to answer on their next drive but missed a 38 yard field goal to the left.

Central Missouri would take full advantage of that when freshman quarterback Tommy Corwin came in to lead his first drive of the season. He took them 79 yards in 11 plays, capped by a one-yard touchdown from Glenn Milner.

Meanwhile the Mules defense was all over the vaunted passing attack of the Bearcats, getting pressure on quarterback Steve Gachette all day long. They sacked him seven times and recorded 16 tackles for loss.

The Mules went back to Czerniewski on the third drive of the game and he kept up the pace, rolling 61 yards in seven plays. It was capped by his second touchdown pass, this time to Edgar Givens from six yards out.

After the UCM defense stopped SBU on fourth down, Corwin came in to try and extend the scoring streak. It wasn't to be though as the Bearcats picked off his pass at the UCM 27. Reigning MIAA Defensive Player of the Week John Wood recorded another sack (his fifth consecutive game) and forced a Gachette fumble that SBU recovered. It did the damage though as the Bearcats were forced to attempt a 49 yard field goal that they missed left.

It took only two plays for the Mules to capitalize again as Czerniewski dumped off a short pass to Milner that he took 58 yards down the middle of the field to set up a 10 yard touchdown run by Jeremy Braden.

The Bearcats would get a touchdown just before the break but the Mules ended the threat on the first drive of the third quarter, going 55 yards in nine plays to make it 35-7. Czerniewski rushed it in from a yard out for his third scoring drive of the game.

The Bearcats scored their final touchdown of the game a couple drives later but the Mules finished strong, scoring three touchdowns in the final period.

Glenn Milner had the answering score, sprinting to a 54 yard touchdown to get him over the 100-yard mark for the sixth time in MIAA play. He also became only the third player in Central Missouri history to go over 100 points in a season (Kegan Coleman and Lee Thompson did it twice each).

Junior Stinson Dean played most of the final quarter and went 3-of-3 for 79 yards and a 17-yard score to Givens.

The Mules recorded 211 yards rushing to tally 538 yards of total offense

on the day. They also held SBU to 287 yards passing on 55 attempts while stopping its rush to only 55 yards.

Milner finished with 120 yards rushing and 178 all-purpose yards while Anthony Parks had 7 catches for 87 yards and 195 all-purpose with his kick and punt returns. Defensively, freshman Jacob Glose stepped up again for the banged up secondary and led the squad with 12 tackles (2.5 for loss). Czerniewski was 11-of-13 for 175 yards as the three QB's combined for a 19-of-23 performance.

The Series & Coaches

This is the 22nd meeting between Southwest Baptist and Central Missouri. The Mules have won the last 17 meetings with the Bearcats, dating back to 1991. They have scored more than 40 points on them 10 different times and lead the overall series 19-2.

Fritz is 11-0 against the Bearcats while Keith Allen is 0-1 as a head coach, and 0-2 as an assistant at SBU against UCM.

Willie Fritz is in his 13th season as head coach at the University of Central Missouri. He is 89-44 as the Mules' mentor, 66-41 vs. MIAA opponents. His .669 winning percentage is fourth best in UCM football history, while **his 89 career wins rank No. 1 in school history.**

A 1983 graduate of Pittsburg State University, he currently ranks eighth in the MIAA in career wins, third among active MIAA coaches.

Keith Allen is in his third season at Southwest Baptist as the head coach after serving as the defensive coordinator and assistant head coach the prior two seasons. He has a 5-17 overall record there and is 0-12 against MIAA opposition.

Scouting the Bearcats

Southwest Baptist comes into 2009 after a 5-6 mark last year. They competed in the Independent Collegiate Athletic Association and return three All-Americans, as well as 12 starters overall.

Individually, the offense returns five starters, headlined by two All-Americans in junior quarterback Steve Gachette and senior wide receiver Johnnie King. Gachette threw for 3,360 yards and 27 TD's in the spread offense last season, while King led the nation with 89 catches, and piled up 1,120 yards with nine TD's. The Bearcats offense averaged 490 yards and 39.5 points per game in 2008.

The Bearcats defense returns six starters, but allowed nearly 450 yards and 34 points per game last season. Senior All-American defensive back Tyrin Holt leads the way with 101 stops, along with senior linebacker Jarred Schumpert with 101 tackles (13 for loss). The Bearcats allowed 141.2 yards rushing and 302.7 yards passing per contest.

Running Game = Success

The Mules are 51-5 since the 2001 season when they have outgained their opponents on the ground versus an 11-21 mark when they have been outrushed by their opponents.

Fritz Special Forces

Mules coach Willie Fritz is known for his attention to special teams. During his tenure, the Mules have **returned 21 punts for touchdowns and eight kickoffs to pay dirt.** And even more impressive, his teams have **blocked 35 punts** during his tenure (including four last year). The school record for blocks in a season is six (set twice, both in Fritz' reign, 2003 and 1999).

Turnover Ratio

The Mules are 40-8 since 2001 when they have won the turnover battle compared to 13-11 when they have committed more turnovers. They are also 9-7 when both teams are tied in turnovers. Following is the break down for positive/negative

For Openers

The Mules are 10-2 in season openers in the Willie Fritz era and have won the lidlifter 10 of the last 11 years. The only losses on opening day came in 2007 at Minnesota State by a 23-14 margin, and in 1997 to Nebraska-Omaha on the road by a 41-12 score.

The Mules have opened the season at home six times, going 6-0. They have also outscored all but one opponent by at least two touchdowns in those games.

Thursday Night Lights

This will be the fifth consecutive season that the Mules have played a Thursday night game. They are 5-1 overall in Thursday games the last four seasons, and 5-0 at home.

Outside the Conference

UCM has been nearly unbeatable in non-conference regular season games under head coach Willie Fritz. They are 22-2 overall and have won 22 of their last 23. Last year the Mules went 2-0, defeating Minnesota State 29-9 and Arkansas Tech 49-13.

In the Polls

They Mules are ranked in the AFCA Preseason top 25 for the first time since 2004, when they were 10th. They come into 2009 ranked 25th.

The Mules have been ranked in the second poll of the D2Football.com rankings on several occasions, but not since 2004 have they been in the preseason poll.

The MIAA Preseason Coaches Poll (pg. 6), as well as the inaugural MIAA Media Poll, ranked the Mules third overall in the conference.

This Week in Mules Football

Cosby named All-American

Junior tight end DeMarco Cosby is the Mules only returning All-American and was honored with preseason first-team All-American honors by Consensus Draft Services this season. He is the first preseason All-American since Kendall Ricketts, and the first on offense since Kegan Coleman in 2004.

Last season he broke the school record for receiving yards by a tight end with 623. He also logged five touchdown grabs and had 29 receptions for a team-high 21.5 yards per catch average.

Super Czerniewski

Mules junior quarterback **Eric Czerniewski** comes into 2009 with high expectations after a record-breaking campaign in 2008. He broke the school record for passing yards (2,938) and total offense (3,010) in a season, as well as touchdowns responsible for (33). He has also had four 300-yard passing games to break that mark.

He is also in the career top 10 in every statistical passing category:

Full Stable

The Mules will be sporting a full crew of five upper classmen running backs this season, four of which are juniors.

Junior **Anthony Stewart** returns after sitting out last season due to a preseason injury. Junior **Zain Gower** played in every contest last year, and also returned kicks. The final returnee is senior **Justin Gore**, who has seen action in 16 career contests.

New to the team are junior transfers **Tywon Hubbard** (Butler County C.C.) and **Ken Hedrington** (Fresno City College).

Thats Offensive

The Mules averaged 34.5 points per game and led the MIAA with 277.8 yards passing per game in 2008. They also racked up more than 400 yards of offense per contest to rank fourth overall. UCM also broke several school records, including the fewest turnovers in a season at 14. UCM returns five starters, including an All-MIAA quarterback, receiver, and tight end from that effort.

In fact, Central Missouri has not been shut out since September 21, 1991 against Missouri Southern. The 192 game streak is the third longest in the nation, and an MIAA record.

Improving the D

UCM will look to improve on the defensive side of the ball in 2009 after a disappointing effort last season. They ranked last in the MIAA in passing and total defense. They look to build on the effort of the run defense, which ranked fourth. UCM also came away with a turnover margin of +7, putting them second in the MIAA.

Newcomers Galore

The Mules lost 16 players from last year's squad that started games, and therefore the coaching staff had to bring in several newcomers by both the freshman and transfer routes.

On the 2009 roster there are 23 true freshmen and 15 transfers. On the latest preseason depth chart, there were 14 transfers and one true freshman, as well as 11 players coming in off a redshirt season.

Mules in the Pros:

There is one Mule on an NFL roster coming into the 2009 season and he is playing for the San Francisco 49ers. Tight end/H-back **Delanie Walker (2004-05)** signed a three-year, \$6 million contract with a \$1.8 million signing bonus in 2008, and had 10 grabs for 155 yards and a touchdown during the year.
