The Game:

The Mules start the regular season slate this Saturday with the annual game against Monmouth. It will be the fifth time in the last six season that UCM has faced MC in the non-conference slate. It is also the season opener for the Fighting Scots as they will play for the first time without long time head coach Dr. Terry Glasgow, who retired at the end of last season.

Mules go 1-1 in CBE Classic against Division I foes

(Columbia, Mo.) – The experience showed for Division I Fordham against the Mules in the first game of the O'Reilly Auto Parts/CBE Classic as it held off a late rally to grab a 76-66 win. Fordham started five senior returners while Central Missouri had five players on the floor that had never started a game in a Mule uniform.

As expected, the Mules got better defensively as the game went on and cut a 19 point Rams lead to only 10 late in the second half. Central Missouri actually out-scored Fordham 35-32 in the second period. The good news for the Mules was that it was an exhibition game, and they get another chance to tune up on Tuesday night against the Central Michigan Chippewas.

Fordham jumped out to a 10-5 lead before the Mules notched their only lead of the night by going on a 6-0 run. They got it on a Nathan Frazier three-pointer but the Rams quickly answered to expand their lead to 11 by the 8:05 mark of the opening period.

The Mules hung tough and kept the advantage to a manageable 44-31 deficit going into halftime. Central Missouri was led by sophomore Tremaine Luellen with 10 at the half while Marcus Stout of the Rams had 14.

Fordham jumped out in the second half early, moving its advantage up to 19, but Central Missouri turned in on defensively from there, going on a 28-19 run to finish the game.

The Mules were led by Luellen with 17 points while senior Kevin Wollbrinck tallied 13 points and six rebounds. Skip Thomas added 12 points on the night to pace Central Missouri. The bigger Rams out-rebounded the Mules 42-33 and out-shot them 44 percent to 37 percent in the outing.

(Columbia, Mo.) – For the first time in school history, the Central Missouri Mules handed a Division I squad a loss as they knocked off Central Michigan 75-70 on Tuesday night in the O'Reilly Auto Parts/ CBE Classic.

Unfortunately for the Mules, the game was considered an exhibition, but the outing counted for the

Chippewas, dropping them to 0-2 on the season after a loss to Mizzou the night before. Central Missouri joined several other Division II squads to knock off Division I foes in the preseason, including Grand Valley State over Michigan State, Findlay taking out Ohio State, Tarleton State beating Baylor, and Cal State San Bernardino over Weber State.

The Mules started the game with the same intensity on the defensive end from the night before against Fordham. They forced nine Central Michigan turnovers and held them to 32 percent from the field. The Chippewas used a 26-to-18 rebound advantage and held UCM to 34 percent shooting to keep the margin close at the break.

With CMU leading 15-10, the Mules went on a 9-0 run to capture the lead and extended that to as much as 27-20 with 2:08 remaining in the period. The Chippewas' Chase Simon hit a three with two seconds left in the half to close the gap. He had 12 in the half. The Mules were led by Carvelle Taylor and Paul Banister with six apiece while Tremaine Luellen had five points in the first two minutes before sitting the remainder of the half due to early foul trouble.

The Chippewas came out charging in the second half as expected, but Central Missouri withstood the run, only allowing CMU to grab only a couple brief two-point leads before answering. Luellen layed one in with 13:22 remaining to give the lead back to the Mules, while Skip Thomas followed that with a dunk off a dish from Kevin Wollbrinck on the next possession. Central Michigan would not lead the rest of the night.

The Mules broke the final tie of the game at the 7:07 mark on another Luellen layup. They would stretch the margin to as much as eight with 4:02 remaining but the Chippewas had another run in them, thanks to the MAC Preseason Player of the Year in Giordan Watson. He drilled four three pointers (two that banked in off the glass) and had 14 points in the final 3:47 of the game. Wollbrinck was big down the stretch to counter that for the Mules though, grabbing big rebounds and forcing turnovers, including a steal from Watson with 1:08 left.

The Mules finished off the Chippewas by simply hitting their free throws to seal the win. Central Michigan was actually picked to win the MAC West Division by Sporting News and is ranked preseason No. 24 in the Mid-Major national poll by collegeinsider.com.

UCM was led by Luellen with 16 points while Taylor had 15 and Thomas put up 14. Wollbrinck led the squad in boards with 10 and assists with four. Nathan Frazier also added 13 off the bench.

The Coaches



In his sixth season at the University of Central Missouri, **Kim Anderson** has moved into elite company. He has led the Mules to a 110-44 (.714) overall record and is the only coach in school history to win at least 24 games three years in a row.

In 2006-07, the Mules finished 31-4, advancing to the NCAA-II Elite Eight and Final Four in Springfield, Mass. It was the second NCAA-II Final Four in school history (1984). The 31 victories established a school record for wins. The Mules also won their second MIAA Regular Season title in three years with a 15-3 mark. During the past four seasons, the Mules are also the winningest team in MIAA play, posting 49 victories.

Anderson's two league crowns are the first two for the Mules since 1984. In addition, the 2006-07 Mules won the MIAA Post-Season Tournament in Kansas City for the second time in three seasons. The two MIAA Tournament crowns are the first for UCM since 1985.

Mark Vershaw is in his first season as the head coach at Monmouth College, taking over for the legendary Dr. Terry Glasgow. This will be his first regular season game for the Fighting Scots. He played at the University of Wisconsin and led the team in scoring and into the Final Four in 2000.

The Series

The Mules are 18-0 against Monmouth and have won all four of the meetings under coach Anderson (last season was an 81-53 Mule win). Central Missouri has won all four games handily with an average victory margin of 32 points. The closest margin between the two squads came back in 1994 when UCM won by two. They also squeaked out an eight-point win back in 1997.

Scouting the Fighting Scots

Monmouth starts their season as well on Saturday and boasts a roster of 21 players. The Fighting Scots return six players that saw action in last season's game including senior center Joe Terwelp. He scored 24 points and had nine boards on Central Missouri last season while Blaise Rogers and Andy Moore also return and tallied 11 and nine points, respectively. They finished the year with an 11-11 overall record in 2006-07.

Anderson joins Mule coaching elite

Mules head coach Kim Anderson got win number 110 against Montevallo last year in only his fifth season. He is already in fifth place on the UCM coaching list (out of 23 coaches) with a 110-44 mark. Up next on the list is Lynn Nance, who was an outstanding 114-35 in five seasons from 1980-85.

Home Court Perfection!

UCM finished its first undefeated season at home since the 1984 season. With the win over SOSU in the regional title game, Central Missouri is 44-3 at the Multipurpose Building in the last four seasons under Anderson. **They have a 24-0 record against non-conference opponents at home during that span as well.** Against MIAA teams, the Mules are 24-3 at home in the last three years.

They have won their last 23 games at the Multi (second longest streak in the nation behind Winona's 33) dating back to a loss to Emporia on January 14 of 2006. They have won 15 in a row at home against MIAA teams.

For Openers

The Mules are 5-0 in season openers under coach Anderson and have not lost one since the 2001-02 season against Evangel by a 20 point margin. That Mules team went on to post a 12-15 record overall. Central Missouri has also won all five of its season lidlifters under Anderson by at least 22 points.

Attendance Leaders

The Mules led all of NCAA Division II in attendance last season with 3,640 fans per game. Central Missouri also ranked highly when put up against Division I schools. The Mules had better attendance than approximately 60 percent of their D-I counterparts and averaged more than schools like the University of Colorado and the University of Miami (Fla.).

Mules Basketball All-Time

Central Missouri Mules basketball is in its 102nd season. The Mules have produced an all-time record of 1451-873. The Mules are the second winningest program in NCAA Division II basketball history (trailing only Central Washington).

Central Missouri has won three national titles--the NAIB titles in 1936-37 (the first ever collegiate basketball championship) and 1937-38, and the NCAA-II title in 1984 at Springfield, Mass.

The Mules have also claimed 20 regular season conference titles (the most of any modern-day MIAA team), four MIAA tournament crowns, and have advanced to the NCAA Tournament 19 times.

D-1 Triumph

The Mules handed a Division I squad a loss for the first time in school history on Tuesday night at the O'Reilly Auto Parts/CBE Classic against Central Michigan. Although the game didn't count for Central Missouri, it did for the Chippewas, dropping them to 0-2 on the year.

Who Are These Guys?

The Mules started five guys on Monday and Tuesday that have never started a game in the Cardinal and Black. In fact, the only returner of the five was senior Kevin Wollbrinck. The other four new guys were junior De'Andre Byrd, sophomore Tremaine Luellen, junior Carvelle Taylor, and junior Skip Thomas.

Luellen Debut

Mules sophomore Tremaine Luellen had a nice debut for Central Missouri in the CBE Classic, scoring a team-high 17 and 16 in the two games. He hit 8-of-16 from the field and had a couple steals while getting to the line for 23 attempts (the next closest Mule had nine attempts).

Wollbrinck steps up

Senior forward Kevin Wollbrinck averaged only 1.3 points and 1.3 rebounds a game last season for the Mules. He also averaged only seven minutes per contest in 2006-07. In the two exhibition games, he averaged a team-high 32 minutes per outing and started both games. He also averaged 10 points and eight rebounds in the game while dishing out six assists.

Mule Ball

Central Missouri won the turnover battle in both of the exhibition games on Monday and Tuesday. They turned those directly into 36 points on the other end (24 against CMU, 12 against FU). That is the formula for "Mule Ball", turning defense into offense.

Going Deep

The Central Missouri Mules showed just how deep they were this week in the exhibition slate as 10 guys played in game one and 11 men saw action against Central Michigan. Not to mention junior post player Walter Battle is out with an injury.

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) - Zack Wright set the tone for the Central Missouri Mules with a three pointer on the first possession and stellar defense all night long against the Fighting Scots of Monmouth College to grab an 81-53 season-opening win.

Central Missouri (1-0) coasted to a 49-22 halftime lead and held MC to 31 percent from the floor while hitting a blistering 52 percent. Wright tallied 13 first half points while Darryl Sommerset chipped in with 10. All phases were clicking for UCM as they also held a 26-13 rebound advantage at the break.

The Mules blew the game wide open in first part of the second stanza though. By the 12:21 mark they had moved the lead to a game-high 42 points (69-27). Central Missouri did it the old fashioned way too, with defense and rebounding. The Mules had a 44-to-27 rebound margin and had 10 steals on the night. They also hit more than 50 percent on the night due to 48 points in the paint. Several easy lay-ups in transition also contributed to the percentage. Every player that UCM suited up got in the game and the Mules had 27 points off the bench.

Wright finished the night with 16 points while Alonzo Brooks put up 15 and Sommerset tallied 14. Wadale Williams had seven assists on the night while Charles Stoker grabbed a team-high nine rebounds. Monmouth was led by Joe Terwelp with 24 points and nine rebounds.
