### The Game:

The Mules will head to Clarksville, Tenn. for the first of two exhibition games this week. The matchup with Austin Peay is set to start at 7:00 p.m. Thursday night. It is the second time the Mules have played an exhibition game against the Governors, falling 94-90 in overtime during the fall of 2005.

### Mules season preview

Most programs could not have done it. The Kim Anderson era Central Missouri Mules aren't most programs though. They had 10 new players and did not return a single person that had ever started a game in a Mule uniform, but went on to post an 18-10 record, and finish in a tie for third at 11-7 in the MIAA. The 2007-08 team got better as the year went, winning eight of their last 10 regular season games and just missing their fourth consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament. The great basketball programs don't rebuild after losing six starters and seven seniors, they reload.

"After losing so many players from the Final Four year, it almost seemed like my first year because of the influx of the new players, but we did get better as the year went on. I thought as the season progressed we became a very good defensive team that surprisingly struggled to score on a consistent basis." Anderson said, "In the offseason, we feel that our recruiting addressed this problem."

The Mules allowed only 63.1 points per game to rank second in the league last year, but scored only 69.7 per game on offense to rank sixth.

Central Missouri returns six players that started a game last year, all of which played more than 10 minutes per game. Combine that with the addition of some talented impact newcomers, and the Mules should push to get back in the NCAA Tournament.

"On paper, we should be a better scoring team, but it really depends on how we gel together to get back to being a more prolific scoring team." Anderson said, "I do think this year's team will have excellent leadership. We have several players that played a lot of minutes a year ago that now understand what it takes to be successful in the MIAA, and are more comfortable with our system and what we are trying to accomplish."

Some of those leaders include seniors De'Andre Byrd, Joe Young, Josiah Miller, and Nathan Frazier. They all have a taste of how things are done at UCM and experienced the always rugged MIAA schedule.

"A year ago I think many had unrealistic expectations for our team coming off a Final Four appearance. Losing seven seniors and having 10 new players was a challenge." Anderson said, "We experienced a bad stretch in January but we recovered. I think with the experience that we have returning and the addition of our new players, we have a chance to improve on last year's standing."

### The Coaches



In his seventh season at the University of Central Missouri, **Kim Anderson** has moved into elite company. He has led the Mules to a 128-54 (.708) overall record and is the only coach in school history to win at least 24 games three years in a row. **Last season, he piloted a team that returned no starters to an 18-10 overall record and a third place finish in the MIAA.**

In 2006-07, the Mules finished 31-4, advancing to the NCAA-II Elite Eight and Final Four in Springfield, Mass. It was the second NCAA-II Final Four in school history (1984). The 31 victories established a school record for wins. The Mules also won their second MIAA Regular Season title in three years with a 15-3 mark. **During the past five seasons, the Mules are also the winningest team in MIAA play, posting 61 victories.**

Anderson's two league crowns are the first two for the Mules since 1984. In addition, the 2006-07 Mules won the MIAA Post-Season Tournament in Kansas City for the second time in three seasons. The two MIAA Tournament crowns are the first for UCM since 1985.

**Dave Loos** is in his 19th season at Austin Peay, and 23rd as a college head coach. He has an overall record of 377-300 and is 295-248 at Austin Peay. He has led the Governors to back-to-back conference titles on the basketball court, as well as serving as the athletic director. He is the winningest coach in school history as well.

### The Series

The Mules are 0-1 against Austin Peay in exhibition games, with the loss coming by a 94-90 margin in overtime on the road in 2005. The connection between the schools is Mules Associate Head Coach Brad Loos is the son of the Head Coach and Athletic Director of Austin Peay, Dave Loos. Brad was a former player and graduated from Austin Peay in May of 2002.

### Scouting the Competition

The Governors of Austin Peay are members of the Ohio Valley Conference in NCAA Division I. They are coming off an NCAA Tournament appearance after winning the Ohio Valley regular season and tournament title.

The Governors went 24-11 and 16-4 in conference action before falling to Texas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament by a 74-54 margin. The 24 wins matched the highest win total in school history.

They return two starters, including All-OVC pick and leading scorer Drake Reed (14.4 ppg, 5.6 rpg). They also return forward Kyle Duncan, who averaged 6.9 points, and 3.3 rebounds per outing.

### Anderson Moving Up the Charts

Mules head coach Kim Anderson got win number 128 in only his sixth season (128-54). He is in fourth place on the UCM coaching list (out of 23 coaches). Up next on the list is Jim Wooldridge, who had a 131-48 mark in six seasons (1985-91).

### MIAA Finishes

The Mules wrapped up their fifth consecutive winning season in MIAA play with an 11-7 mark last year to finish tied for third. They are the only team in the league above .500 in each year, as well as the only team with double-digit victories in each of those seasons.

Central Missouri has also finished at least fourth in the regular season race in each of those seasons, a feat that only Northwest Missouri has accomplished the last five years.

### In the Polls

Central Missouri has gained the respect as a national power over the last seven seasons under Kim Anderson. They are receiving votes in the preseason NABC poll and were picked to finish second in the MIAA for the second consecutive year. They have been picked to win the league or finish second the last four years in the preseason poll.

### Mules Basketball All-Time

Central Missouri Mules basketball is in its 103rd season. The Mules have produced an all-time record of 1469-883. The Mules are the second winningest program in NCAA Division II basketball history (trailing only Central Washington).

Central Missouri has won three national titles--the NAIB titles in 1936-37 (the first ever collegiate basketball championship) and 1937-38, and the NCAA-II title in 1984 at Springfield, Mass.

The Mules have also claimed 20 regular season conference titles (the most of any modern-day MIAA team), four MIAA tournament crowns, and have advanced to the NCAA Tournament 19 times.

### Rule Change

The NCAA Basketball Rules committee has changed the length of the three-point line for 2008-09. It has been moved back a full foot to 20-feet, nine-inches.

## Last Time They Met

~ Mules 90, Austin Peay 94, OT ~  
November 2005 \* Clarksville, Tenn.

(CLARKSVILLE, Tenn.) – Don't tell the Central Missouri State University Mules or the Austin Peay State University Governors they were playing an exhibition at Austin Peay. The two teams battled for 40 minutes before the Governors, an NCAA Division I member of the Ohio Valley Conference, held on for a 94-90 win. It did not come easy.

The Mules carried a 12-5 lead into the first media time out at 15:51 of the first half. CMSU used some aggressive defense to force three Austin Peay turnovers in that span and also took advantage of three quick APSU fouls to convert 3-of-4 from the free throw line.

Coming out of the break, though, the Governors went on a 7-3 run to close the gap to 15-13. The Mules answered on an Andrae Brown 12-footer from the right wing and a Corey Brown trey to boost the lead back up to seven by the 11:59 mark, 20-13.

Back came the Governors. Landon Shipley drove the right side of the lane and then drained a three to bring APSU back within two, 20-18. A Drake Reed lay up at 9:21 tied the score at 22-22, and when Reed hit both ends of a one-and-one at 8:40, the Gobs had a 24-22 lead.

The Mules regained the lead, 30-29, at 5:30 on Michael Hicks' three-pointer. But Maurice "Squeaky" Hampton gave the lead back to APSU at 3:43, 35-34, on a three-pointer of his own.

The lead changed hands once again when Hicks hit three free throws coming out of the final media timeout of the first half to put Central Missouri on top 37-35.

But at 1:01, Hampton drained a pair of free throws to knot the score at 39-39, and with :37 left in the half, Tomas Janusauskas gave the Governors a 40-39 lead by hitting one-of-two free throws. Shipley pushed the lead to two, 41-40, by hitting one of two with :05 on the clock, but Wadale Williams made sure it didn't last as he brought the ball up the floor and drained a three-pointer at the buzzer to send CMSU into the intermission with a 42-41 advantage.

The Mules were out-shot in the first half, 52.2 percent to 48.1 percent, but owned a 15-to-11 rebound advantage.

Typical of the first game of the year, the opening 20 minutes featured plenty of fouls (27, 16 on CMSU) and turnovers (18). The first half also saw seven ties and nine lead changes.

The Mules' lead lasted all of 11 seconds into the second half, as Derek Wright got a steal and while hitting the breakaway lay up was fouled by Hicks. His free throw made it 44-42, Austin Peay.

Central Missouri went on an 8-2 run into the first media time out of the second half (at the 15:55 mark), though, and grabbed a 50-46 advantage.

Austin Peay used a 12-3 run of its own to take the lead back, 58-53, with 12:05 to play. But the Mules would not go away, and with 7:46 to play Theo Jones drained a 15-footer to tie the game again at 64-64.

Of course, Austin Peay had an answer of its own, and by the final media time out at 3:55 had a 75-71 lead, courtesy of two Zac Schlader free throws and a Kyle Duncan lay up.

The lead swelled to eight, 79-71, with 3:41 when Duncan got a steal and lay up, and was 10, 84-74, following ZSchlader's three-point play with 2:38 to go.

The Mules would not go quietly. A 13-4 run, capped by a Hicks steal and lay up brought Central Missouri within one, 88-87, with :39 to play.

After Brown was whistled for a foul on the in-bounds pass, Hampton hit a pair of free throws with :38 to go to put the Governors up 90-87, but that just set the table for Hicks to drain a guarded three from the left sideline with :31 to play, tying the score at 90 apiece.

But with :10 left, Jones was whistled for a reach foul, and Hampton canned both free throws. When Hicks' desperation three-pointer fell short, it was all over for the Mules. Hampton was fouled on the rebound and drained both free throws to ice the win for Austin Peay, 94-90.

It was actually free throws down the stretch that cost the Mules, as they hit just 9-of-17 (52.9 percent) down the stretch, 21-of-31 (67.7 percent) for the game. Austin Peay, meanwhile, nailed 34-of-38 from the charity stripe, including all 20 in the second half.

Despite the fact the game does not count toward their record, the Mules were disappointed. Their mentor, though, said the squad could learn much for the contest.

"They felt terrible (after the game)," Anderson said. "They wanted to win this basketball game, but I think we got so much out of this. This video will be a great teaching tool for us."

Hicks paced CMSU with 27 points and three steals. Williams added 16 points, five rebounds, and six assists, and Jones added 14 points, four rebounds, and four assists. Corey Brown was also in double-digits with 10 points. Darryl Somerset was the Mules' leading rebounder with seven, as CMSU out-rebounded its host 30-to-28. The Mules drained 9-of-22 (40.9 percent) from three-point range and 53.6 percent from the floor. Austin Peay shot 49.1 percent, 28.6 percent (6-of-21) from beyond the arc.
