### The Game:

The Mules will hit the road to open MIAA play on Tuesday night to face seventh ranked Southwest Baptist in Bolivar, Mo. The Bearcats were picked to win the MIAA while UCM was selected to end up second. The two squads split the season series last year with each winning on its home floor.

### Mules light up Vikings, 96-63

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – The Central Missouri Mules moved to 5-0 heading into MIAA play with a 96-63 thumping of Missouri Valley on Saturday night in the UCM Multipurpose Building. They used a 40-13 run over the final eight minutes of the first half to cruise in the outing.

Central Missouri never trailed in the game despite leading by only three with 9:19 left in the opening period. By the 6:03 mark, it was a double-digit advantage, and it would never be less than that the rest of the night. UCM used turnovers to go on a run to end the half, totaling 20 points off miscues to make it a 54-26 total at the break.

Junior guard Alex Moosmann powered the offense with 14 points in the stanza while classmate Tremaine Luellen and senior De'Andre Byrd each had nine in the period. UCM shot 52.6 percent while out-rebounding the Vikings 22-11. UCM also used 16 second-chance points off 11 offensive boards to push ahead.

Central Missouri would push the lead to as many as 32 with 11:29 left in the second stanza as Esian Henderson scored 12 of his career-high 14 points in the period. It is the second consecutive game he has set a career-high. Luellen also had 10 points and six boards in the half.

The Mules cruised in the stanza, out-scoring the Vikings 42-37. They also tallied 14 assists in the half.

Central Missouri shot 50.7 percent for the game and finished with the highest point total of the season.

Luellen finished the night with 19 points and 10 rebounds on 8-of-12 shooting. It was the first double-double for the Mules since March of last season. Moosmann and Henderson each finished with 14 and Joe Young scored eight in the second half to tally 11.

**Anderson Third on the Charts**

Mules head coach Kim Anderson got win number 133 Saturday in only his seventh season (133-54). He is now third place on the UCM coaching list (out of 23 coaches). Next up on the list is Earl Keth, who won 159 games in 15 seasons (1946-61).

**MIAA Finishes**

The Mules wrapped up their fifth consecutive winning season in MIAA play with an 11-7 mark last year to finish tied for third. They are the only team in the league above .500 in each year, as well as the only team with double-digit victories in each of those seasons.

Central Missouri has also finished at least fourth in the regular season race in each of those seasons, a feat that only the Mules and Northwest Missouri have accomplished the last five years.

**In the Polls**

Central Missouri has gained the respect as a national power over the last seven seasons under Kim Anderson. They were receiving votes in the preseason NABC poll and were picked to finish second in the MIAA for the second consecutive year. They have been picked to win the league or finish second the last four years in the preseason poll.

**Mules Basketball All-Time**

Central Missouri Mules basketball is in its 103rd season. The Mules have produced an all-time record of 1473-883. The Mules are the second winningest program in NCAA Division II basketball history (trailing only Central Washington).

Central Missouri has won three national titles--the NAIB titles in 1936-37 (the first ever collegiate basketball championship) and 1937-38, and the NCAA-II title in 1984 at Springfield, Mass.

The Mules have also claimed 20 regular season conference titles (the most of any modern-day MIAA team), four MIAA tournament crowns, and have advanced to the NCAA Tournament 19 times.

**Off the Bench**

Central Missouri has shown its depth this season with their points off the bench. It has averaged 34.6 points per outing off the bench while allowing only 22 per game from its opponents. De'Andre Byrd and Esian Henderson are the leaders for the Mules, averaging 9.4 and 7.2 points per game.

**Super Starts**

**Pros to play under Anderson**

- 28 former players have gone on to play professionally in the NBA or overseas.
- Six former Mules are currently playing or have played overseas.
- Of the total, at least nine players have played in the NBA.
- Five former players have been drafted by an NBA team in the first round.
- Anderson was a second round pick by the Portland Trailblazers and also played in Europe.

**Mules vs. Ranked Competition**

Central Missouri is 14-11 against ranked opponents the last five years under Anderson.

UCM is 4-4 against ranked MIAA teams the last three seasons, defeating Northwest Missouri twice, Emporia once, and PSU once.

**MIAA Openers**

The Mules are 6-0 in MIAA openers during the Kim Anderson era. They are 4-0 vs. PSU, 1-0 vs. WU, and 1-0 vs. TSU.

## Last Time They Met

~ Mules 57, Southwest Baptist 66 ~  
February 26, 2008 \* Bolivar, Mo.

(Bolivar, Mo.) – The Central Missouri Mules made a valiant effort on Tuesday night against the Southwest Baptist Bearcats, but they got in too big of a hole to come all the way back, falling 66-57 on the road. SBU clinched the MIAA regular season title and finished up a perfect 15-0 record at Meyer Sports Center this season.

To say the Mules (17-9, 10-7 MIAA) and Bearcats (20-6, 13-4 MIAA) started slow on offense would be an understatement. At the 12 minute mark, the two squads combined for a lowly 3-of-28 from the floor and the score was tied 4-4. The defenses were full of energy as every shot was contested. It would pick up just a little on offense after that, but neither team could gain control of the game as the Mules biggest lead was six at 10-4. The Bearcats chipped away though, grabbing their first lead of the game on a free throw with two seconds remaining to make it 22-21 at the break.

Central Missouri hit just 22.6 percent in the period while SBU hit 25.7 percent. Nobody had more than four points for the Mules and the Bearcats were led by Matt Rogers with 10 points and nine rebounds.

Southwest Baptist came out on a tear in the second half, taking a lead and extending it to nine on a Jim Grabowski three pointer at the 16:54 mark. Central Missouri had some chances to get back into it, but went cold from the free-throw line as it his only 5-of-14 to start the second period. The Bearcats took advantage of the missed opportunities too, moving the margin up to a 19-point advantage with 9:49 remaining.

Joe Young tried to get the Mules back in it though, scoring 10 consecutive points in less than three minutes to cut it to 53-45 with 5:24 left. Rogers answered for the Bearcats to get it back to 13 a minute later but the Mules wouldn't quit. A bucket and a free throw by Josiah Miller followed by a three from Young with 35 seconds left cut it to six, but it was too late.

The Mules hit a season-low 27.9 percent from the field in the game while SBU heated up a little in the second stanza and finished with a 32.8 percent showing. The Bearcats also had a 54-47 advantage on the boards in the outing, despite a 14-to-9 turnover deficit.

The Mules were led by Young with 21 points, while he also had a career-high nine boards and three steals. Miller matched his career-mark with 10 points in the game and Skip Thomas led the rebounding effort with 11. Rogers led the Bearcats with 21 points and 17 rebounds.

Central Missouri (1-0) used stellar defense and got points from 12 different players in the win. The new seating in the Multi saw just more than 2,000 fans as the Mules defeated the Division III Blue Jays (0-1) for the fifth time under Anderson.
