**The Game:** The Jennies are on the road again. They travel to Kirksville to face off with Truman on Friday and then head to Maryville to meet up with Northwest Missouri.

### Last time out

**Missouri Southern:** The Jennies won their fifth straight game thanks to a goal from **Lindsay Hoerl**. She found the back of the net in the 81st minute to give UCM a 1-0 win. The Jens out-shot Missouri Southern 8-3 in the second half and were tied 11-11 for the game. **Liz Casey** made seven saves and recorded her third shutout of the season.

**Southwest Baptist:** The Jennies completed the weekend sweep with another 1-0 win. **Angela Dobbie** netted her first goal of the season off an assist from **Randi Fernsler**. Casey made four more saves and recorded her third shutout in the past four games. The win gave Jennies a 5-0 conference record, their best start in school history.

**The Coaches:** **Lewis Theobald** is in his first season at the helm of the Jennies soccer program. His career record stands at 7-1-1, 5-0 in the MIAA. He spent last season as the first assistant at Division I Indiana State where he was the lead recruiter. He was also in charge of scouting as well as game and player evaluations. He is a 1999 graduate of the University of Kansas.

**Mike Cannon** is in his 15th season as the head man at Truman. His career record is 190-68-24. Last season he led the Bulldogs to a 12-5-3 record and a fourth place finish in the MIAA. It was the first time Truman had not won the MIAA title. He is a 1992 graduate of Truman.

**Tracy Hoza** is in her fifth season at the helm of the Northwest Missouri State soccer program. Her overall record is 23-52-10. She is the winningest coach in Northwest soccer history.

**The Series:** This will be the 19th meeting between Central Missouri and Truman. The Bulldogs lead the overall series 14-3-1. The teams split last season's games with each school winning 1-0 on the other's home field.

This will be the 15th meeting between the Jennies and Northwest Missouri State. UCM holds a 9-2-3 margin in the overall series. The Jennies were 1-0-1 against the Bearcats last season, winning 2-0 in Warrensburg and playing to a 2-2 tie in Maryville.

**Truman:** The Bulldogs come into the game with a record of 6-3-0, 3-1-0 in the MIAA. Last weekend Truman defeated Washburn 2-0 and Emporia State 7-0. They are led by Jessica Weigert (4g, 2a), Katelyn Talcott (3g, 3a) and reigning MIAA defensive player of the week, Emily Newsham.

**Northwest Missouri State:** The Bearcats enter this weekend with a 2-6-0 record and 1-3-0 in MIAA play. They split a pair of games last weekend, defeating Emporia State 3-2 before losing to Washburn 2-0. The Bearcats are led by Amanda Deml (3g, 3a) and Andrea Freeman (1g, 1a). The Bearcats host Missouri Western on Friday before welcoming the Jennies to Maryville.

**Jennies climb in the polls:** The Jennies continue to climb in the NSCAA National Rankings. This week UCM is ranked sixth in the country moving up from eighth last week, a new school record. They continue to hold down the top spot in the NSCAA Central Region ranking.

**Unbeaten in MIAA:** The Jennies are 5-0 in MIAA play for the first time in school history. The previous best start was 4-0 in 1999.

**Jennies on a roll:** The Jennies have won six consecutive games and are unbeaten in their last eight. This is UCM's longest winning streak since beginning last season 6-0. The Jennies last won seven straight in 2001-02 when they ended the 2001 season with six straight wins and started 2002 with two in a row.

**MIAA statistical leaders:** **Liz Casey** is first in the MIAA in shutouts per game (0.80) and goals against average (0.00). **Hazel Cox** is currently third in the MIAA in shots per game (4.14). **Randi Fernsler** is sixth in assists per game (0.33). As a team, the Jennies are first in the MIAA in goals allowed (6), goals against average (0.64) and shutouts per game (0.67). The Jennies have only allowed one goal in MIAA play.
