**The Game:** The fifth-ranked Jennies host a pair of MIAA games this weekend. UCM will play Southwest Baptist on Friday night then welcome the Lions of Missouri Southern to Warrensburg on Saturday night.

### Last time out

**Missouri Western:** The Jennies raced past the Griffons 5-0 last Thursday night. **Lindsay Hoerl** started the scoring in the 18th minute.

**Melanie Hall** scored twice - her fifth and sixth goals of the season - in a span of 2:51 to put the Jennies ahead 3-0. UCM added two more goals in the second half, **Kayla Jupp** scored in the 57th minute for a 4-0 lead and **Kelsi McCrite** notched her first goal of the season in the 86th minute. **Liz Casey** and **Lauren Bamvakais** combined on the shutout with Casey improving to 7-0-1 on the year.

**The Coaches:** **Lewis Theobald** is in his first season at the helm of the Jennies soccer program. His career record stands at 9-1-2, 7-0-1 in the MIAA. He spent last season as the first assistant at Division I Indiana State where he was the lead recruiter. He was also in charge of scouting as well as game and player evaluations. He is a 1999 graduate of the University of Kansas.

**Ben Wade** is in his third year as the head coach of Southwest Baptist. He record at SBU is 20-17-11. He is a 1993 graduate of the University of Tennessee.

**Trevor Wachsman** is in his fifth season as the head man at Missouri Southern. His career record is 43-33-17. He is a 2000 graduate of Fort Lewis (Colo.).

**The Series:** This will be the 21st meeting between Southwest Baptist and Central Missouri. The Jennies hold a 13-7 advantage including a 1-0 win over the Bearcats on September 22 in Bolivar.

This is the 16th meeting between Missouri Southern and the Jennies. UCM holds a slim 7-6-2 lead. The Jens beat the Lions 1-0 on September 21 in Joplin.

**Southwest Baptist:** The Bearcats come into the game at 6-4-2, 5-2-1 in MIAA play. SBU went 1-1 last weekend. They defeated Missouri Southern 1-0 in overtime in Joplin on Friday then dropped a 3-0 decision at Drury (Mo.) on Saturday. The Bearcats are led by Dominie Emmanuel (6g, 1a) and goalkeeper Aline Lopes (0.73 GAA, two shutouts).

**Missouri Southern:** The Lions come into the weekend slate with a record of 8-3-2 overall and 4-3-1 in the MIAA. Missouri Southern dropped a 1-0 decision to Southwest Baptist last Friday. They play at Missouri Western on Friday night before coming to Warrensburg on Saturday. The Lions are led by Nikki Llewellyn (11g, 2a), Sarah Evers (3g, 1a) and goalkeeper Kaney Tyler (0.70 GAA, four shutouts).

**Jennies in the polls:** The Jennies jumped two spots to fifth in this week's NSCAA National Poll, the highest ranking in school history. The Jennies are third behind Minnesota State-Mankato and Winona State (Minn.) in this week's NCAA region rankings. The NCAA region rankings are used to determine who will make the 48-team NCAA tournament in November. The top six teams in each region qualify for the tournament.

**Unbeaten in MIAA:** The Jennies remain unbeaten in MIAA play with a 7-0-1 record. The Jens' last conference loss was October 18 of last season, a 1-0 setback to Washburn, a span of 12 straight MIAA games without a loss.

**Jennies on a roll:** The Jennies pushed their unbeaten streak to 11 with last Thursday's 5-0 win over Missouri Western. It is the longest such streak in Jennies soccer history. The Jennies have not lost since their 3-1 season opening loss to Midwestern State.

**MIAA statistical leaders:** **Liz Casey** is tied for second in the MIAA in shutouts (4), first in goals against average (0.25) and fourth in saves per game (3.88). **Lindsay Hoerl** is tied for first with three game-winning goals. **Hazel Cox** is tied for second in the MIAA in shots per game (4.00) and sixth with 0.30 assists per game. **Randi Fernsler** is eighth in assists per game (0.25). **Melanie Hall** is tied for fourth in points per game (1.00) and tied for eighth in shots per game (2.00). As a team, the Jennies are tied for first in the MIAA in goals allowed (8), goals allowed per game (0.67), goals against average (0.63) and shutouts per game (0.58).
