The Game: The Jennies hit the road for a pair of key MIAA games. UCM travels to to Emporia, Kan. on Friday to take on Emporia State before heading to Topeka for a Saturday night showdown with Washburn. The Jennies are tied with Truman State atop the MIAA standings at 7-2-1 (22 pts) with four games remaining in the regular season.

Last time out

Southwest Baptist: The Jennies dropped their first conference game of the season, a 3-2 double overtime loss to Southwest Baptist. The loss also ended the Jennies' 11-game unbeaten streak (9-0-2). The Jennies jumped out to an early lead when **Brittany Sharp** scored the first goal of her career in the third minute. The Lady Bearcats came right back and tied the game in the eighth minute. SBU took a 2-1 lead late when they scored in the 86th minute, but **Hazel Cox** responded with a goal of her own less than a minute later to force overtime. SBU scored the game-winner in the 103rd minute. The physical game saw 34 fouls and six yellow cards handed out.

Missouri Southern: Looking to rebound from their first conference loss the Jennies suffered another setback, a 2-0 loss to Missouri Southern. UCM out-shot the Lions 5-1 in the first half, but were unable to get on the board. MSSU took the lead in the 59th minute and added an insurance goal in the 84th minute for the 2-0 win. **Hazel Cox** led the Jennies offensive attack with four shots. **Liz Casey** was in net for the Jens and saw her season record dip to 7-2-1.

The Coaches: **Lewis Theobald** is in his first season at the helm of the Jennies soccer program. His career records stands at 9-3-2, 7-2-1 in the MIAA. He spent last season as the first assistant at Division I Indiana State where he was the lead recruiter. He was also in charge of scouting as well as game and player evaluations. He is a 1999 graduate of the University of Kansas.

Jim Schneiderhahn is in his second year as head coach of Emporia State. His career record is 3-30-1. He was the recruiting coordinator and keepers coach at Division I Tulane before taking the Hornets head job.

Tim Collins is in his fifth year leading the women's soccer program at Washburn. His career record is 42-35-18 including 7-5-4 this season. Last season he led the Lady Blues to a 15-1-6 mark and the MIAA championship.

The Series: This will be the 14th meeting between Emporia State and Central Missouri. The Jennies hold a 9-3-1 series lead including a 6-0 win back on September 15.

This is the 10th overall meeting between Washburn and the Jennies. UCM holds a slim 5-3-1 lead. The Jens beat the Lady Blues 1-0 September 14 in Warrensburg.

Emporia State: The Hornets come into the game at 0-15-0 overall and 0-10-0 in the MIAA. Last weekend ESU lost to Truman 3-0 and Northwest Missouri 2-0. The Hornets are led by Sarah Tetuan (3g) and Caitlin Riemer (3g).

Washburn: The Lady Blues come into the weekend slate with a record of 7-5-4 overall and 5-2-3 in MIAA play. Washburn tied Northwest Missouri 1-1 last Friday and defeated Truman State 2-1 on Saturday. They are led by Jessican Mainz (14g, 6a), Daniella Ayala (5g, 4a) and goalkeeper Ashley Klone (0.61 GAA, four shutouts).

Jennies in the polls: The Jennies dropped out of this week's NSCAA National poll after suffering their first two conference losses. The Jennies were ranked fifth last week. The Jens also dropped two spots to fifth in this week's NCAA Central Region poll. The top six teams in the region make the 48-team NCAA tournament.

MIAA statistical leaders: **Liz Casey** is tied for third in the MIAA in shutouts (4), second in goals against average (0.70) and fifth in saves per game (3.80). **Lindsay Hoerl** is tied for second with three game-winning goals. **Hazel Cox** is third in the MIAA in shots per game (3.88) and eighth with 0.25 assists per game. **Randi Fernsler** is ninth in assists per game (0.21). **Melanie Hall** is eighth in points per game (0.86).
