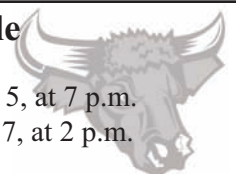
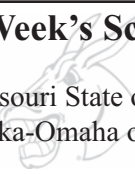

The Game: The Jennies will host the final two games of the season this week as Northwest Missouri and Nebraska-Omaha come to Warrenburg. UCM will honor its seniors on Saturday prior to the game.

The Week in Review

Truman State - Central Missouri defeated the Bulldogs for the sixth time in program history on Saturday, shutting them out 2-0. Melanie Hall scored the game winner in the 19th minute of the contest, beating three TSU defenders and getting the ball passed an outstretched net-minder. Kelsie Hanson scored her first collegiate goal in the 57th minute, receiving a pass from Cara Hennahane. Lauren Bamvakais posted her ninth shutout of the season, saving both shots she faced. The Jennies recorded nine shots, six on goal as Truman State collected eight, two on goal.

Southwest Baptist - The Jennies defeated SBU for the second time in a week as they won 2-1 in Bolivar, Mo. on Monday. Melanie Hall took a shot after Alyssa Rhodes hit the post with a shot and scored the first goal of the game in the 16th minute. Five minutes later, Kelsie Hanson scored the game-winner. Central Missouri collected 14 shots, five on goal, as Southwest Baptist record nine shots, three of which where on target.

The Coaches

Lewis Theobald is in his third season at the helm of the Jennies soccer program. He led the Jens to back-to-back conference titles and has posted a 38-13-8 overall mark. He was the first assistant at Division I Indiana State where he was the lead recruiter before coming to UCM. He is a 1999 graduate of the University of Kansas.

Tracy Hoza begins her seventh season as the head coach at Northwest Missouri State. The Bearcats went 10-8-2 last season and finished sixth in the MIAA with a 6-8-2 record. Hoza holds a 37-65-13 career record in her seven years at NWMSU. She is a 1995 graduate of Mercyhurst.

Don Klosterman enters his 11th season as the head coach at Nebraska-Omaha. The Mavericks went 13-6 last season and finished third in the conference with an 11-5 mark. Klosterman holds a 170-39-7 record in his 11 years at UNO. He is a 1974 graduate of Benedictine.

The Opponents

Northwest Missouri: The Bearcats posted a program-record 11 wins as they are 11-6-1 overall this season and 7-6-1 in the MIAA. Northwest Missouri is 4-3 on the road.

Andrea Tritz leads the Bearcats with seven goals this season, four of which are game-winners. She also has taken a team-high 57 shots. Sara Meidlinger has assisted on nine goals. Kira Lazenby has played every minute in goal for the Bearcats, allowing 16 goals and saving 92 shots. She has shutout the opponents eight times this season.

Central Missouri and Northwest Missouri will meet for the 19th time in program history. UCM holds a 12-3-4 record against the Bearcats as the two teams tied earlier this season in Maryville, Mo.

No. 23 Nebraska-Omaha: The Mavericks have a 13-4-1 overall record and a conference best 12-1-1 mark. Nebraska-Omaha is 4-3-1 away from their home pitch. UNO will travel to Bolivar, Mo. to face Southwest Baptist before coming to Warrensburg.

Nicole Baier leads the Mavericks and the MIAA with 16 goals, 11 assists, 81 shots and six game winning goals. Jessica Powers has scored eight times, while assisting on seven and taking 36 shots. Lauren Fox, Elizabeth Odorisio and Caitlin Stier have shared time in net for UNO as Fox has started all but five games. Fox has allowed 12 goals and as saved 55 shots, posting a 11-1-1 record. Odorisio has a 2-3 record in goal, allowing five goals and saving 10 shots.

This will mark the 12th time Central Missouri and Nebraska-Omaha will face each other, as UNO holds a 10-1 advantage. The Mavericks won 2-0 earlier this season in Omaha, Neb.

Home Sweet Home: The Jennies are 76-39-4 overall at home since the 1995 season. From 1995-2001 when UCM played at Vernon Kennedy Field, the Jennies were 26-18-0. After moving to the South Recreation Complex in 2002, Central Missouri is 50-21-3 including a 6-0 mark this season.

Central Missouri has scored 14 goals at home this season, while giving up only one.

One for the Record: The Jennies defeated Truman State on Saturday Oct. 31 for the sixth time in program history. In the series, TSU leads 15-6-3 since 1995. UCM won in 2008 at home by a 1-0 score and the two teams tied 2-2 at Kirksville, Mo.

Winning Way: Central Missouri won its 11th game on Monday, as they have now won 11 or more games in a season for the fifth straight year. This is also the third straight season that the Jennies have won 10 or more games in the conference.

Taking Shots: Central Missouri has taken 284 shots this season, facing 122. The majority of those shots have been taken in the second half as UCM has taken 150 in the last 45 minutes of play. The Jennies have out-shot all of their opponents except for Texas A&M-Commerce (6-4) and Nebraska-Omaha (13-12), where they are 1-1 in those games.

Hall of Leaders: Melanie Hall leads the Jennies in goals (11), shots (72), shots on goal (42) assists (4) and game-winning goals (4). After scoring in back-to-back games this weekend, Hall has 38 goals in her career as a Jenny. She passed April Reyes (2000-03) and Teleshia Joseph (2001-03) on the all-time goals list as they both ended their careers with 37 goals. In the MIAA, Hall is tied for fifth with those 38 goals. The record is 59 held by Sara Murray of Truman.

Student-Athlete of the Week: For the third time this season, Lauren Bamvakais has been named the Defensive Player of the Week for the week of Oct. 26-31. She was also named to this honor the weeks of Oct. 15-18 and Sept. 10-12.

Jennies against ranked opponents: Central Missouri will face the only MIAA team in the NSCAA/Adidas Division II Rankings this week in No. 23 Nebraska-Omaha. The Jennies are 5-1-2 under Coach Theobald against ranked opponents and 6-6-2 against ranked opponents since 2005. UCM defeated then-No. 16 Texas A&M-Commerce earlier in the season, 1-0, in the TAMUC Tournament.

Regional Rankings: Central Missouri held its spot in the South Central Region as the No. 9 team, as it was released on Oct. 28. Other MIAA teams in the poll are Truman at No. 3, Nebraska-Omaha at No. 5 and Northwest Missouri State at No. 10. The new poll will be released on Nov. 4.

In the MIAA: Central Missouri leads the conference in multiple categories including shots (284) and goals allowed (11). The Jennies have also taken a league high 113 corners this season.

Central Missouri is currently one of five team on a winning streak. The Jennies have won the past five games, as Nebraska-Omaha has gone 8-0-1 in the past nine games. Missouri Western (3-0-1), Northwest Missouri State (1-0-0) and Washburn (1-0-0) all are working on win streaks as well.

Lauren Bamvakais leads the conference with nine shutouts and a .59 goals against average this season. She is eighth in saves with 50.

Melanie Hall is in the top-three in most offensive categories as she has taken 72 shots (second), recorded 26 points (second), scored 11 goals (third) and four game winners (tied for third).

In Division II: Central Missouri is ranked in the NCAA Division II in four of the five categories. The Jennies sit at No. 19 in goals against average (.589), No. 37 in shutout percentage (.500), No. 56 in save percentage (.820) and No. 59 in win-lose-tied percentage (.667). Last week UCM was 22nd in GA average and 71st in WLT percentage.

Individually, Melanie Hall and Lauren Bamvakais are both in the top-100 in two different categories. Hall is No. 89 for points per game (1.44) and No. 75 for goals per game (.611). Bamvakais is sitting at No. 24 in Division II with a .589 goals against average and at No. 59 with a .820 save percentage. This is the first week for Hall being in the national rankings, as Bamvakais was 24th and 53rd respectively.
