

JENNIES' SOCCER TEAM TRAVELS NORTH THIS WEEKEND

WARRENSBURG, MO (August 29, 2000) -- Central Missouri State's women's soccer team travels north for weekend number two of the toughest schedule in the program's brief history. After gaining a split last weekend against Division I foes Southwest Missouri and Drury, coach Al Iantorno's squad will take on Winona State and North Dakota State this weekend in Winona, Minnesota. Saturday (Sept. 2) the Jennies meet Winona State at 2 p.m. and Sunday (Sept. 3) they'll play North Dakota State at 11 a.m. Winona State was 16-3-1 last season and was ranked fourth in its final region rankings, while North Dakota State was 14-2-2 and ranked third in the final region rankings.

The Jennies beat Winona State 1-0 in two overtimes last season at Warrensburg. They are 2-1 against North Dakota State, winning the last meeting between the two teams 5-0 in 1998.

Following a 3-1 loss to Southwest Missouri in their season opener last weekend, the Jennies came back to beat Drury 2-1 the next day. Newcomer Katie Smith scored the Jennies' goal against Southwest Missouri. Another newcomer, April Reyes, produced the game-winning goal in the second half against Drury.
