

JENNIES' SOCCER TEAM CONTINUES TOUGH SCHEDULE

WARRENSBURG, MO (September 11, 2000) -- Central Missouri State's women's soccer team continues its travels on the road, as the Jennies go to Omaha, Nebraska, this weekend (Sept. 16-17) to face a pair of regionally-ranked teams in the Nebraska-Omaha Ramada Inn Classic. Saturday the Jennies meet Northern Colorado (3-2), which is ranked fourth in the Central Region rankings this week by the National Soccer Coaches Association. Sunday the Jennies take on Nebraska-Omaha (4-2), which is ranked seventh in the Central Region. Both matches are at 3 p.m. Truman State is the other team in the classic. Coach Al Iantorno's Jennies, who last week climbed to third in the regional rankings for their highest regional ranking ever, are 4-2 after splitting a pair of matches last weekend. They are ranked sixth in the Central Region this week.

Last weekend the Jennies dropped a 2-1 overtime decision to Southern Illinois-Edwardsville, then blanked Missouri-St. Louis 2-0 as goalkeeper Carrie Payne recorded career complete-game shutout number 19. Despite playing less than 30 minutes per game due to an injury, freshman April Reyes is the Jennies' top scorer with three goals.
