34 - 2008 UCM CROSS COUNTRY RESULTS

Jennies 9th, Mules 10th at NCAA-II South Central Regional

(Joplin, Mo.) - Jennies finish ninth and the Mules were 10th in the NCAA-II South-Central Regional in Joplin, Missouri. Sandy Davidson was the top individual runner for the Jennies with a 10th place finish in the women's division, while the Mules top finisher in the men's division was Anthony Schulz in 33rd place. Neither of the two UCM squads advanced any runners to the national championships in Joplin on November 17th.

Mules and Jennies both sixth at MIAA Championships

(Warrensburg, Mo.)- The Mules and Jennies cross country squads ran to sixth-place finishes at the MIAA Championships at Keth Memorial Golf Course at Pertle Springs in Warrensburg.

The women (6k run) were led by an All-MIAA performance by freshman Carrie Roberts, who finished sixth (23:09.23). Senior Sandy Davidson was the only other UCM finisher in the top 20 as she took 12th (23:29.79).

The men (8k run) were paced by All-MIAA sophomore Brett Carter, who finished sixth (25:42.49). Senior Anthony Schulz finished 16th (26:21.75) to place in the top 20.

The women scored 141 points and fell behind top finisher Missouri Southern who scored 42. The Mules scored 133 points, well behind conference champion Southwest Baptist, who had 63.

(Mankato, Minn.) – UCM Track and Field picked up a total of three All-American finishes at the NCAA Division II Indoor Championships in Mankato, Minn., with one Saturday and two on Friday.

Senior **Haley Morrissey** tied for 8th place in the Women's High Jump on Saturday to earn All-American honors. The Mules senior **Dan Raithel** and freshman **Drew Frizzell** produced the first two All-American finishes for UCM on Friday, finishing 4th and 5th in the Men's Weight Throw.

Junior **Chelsea Luck** failed to qualify for the finals in the 60 meter hurdles. Freshman **Jenna Schmidt** finished 12th in the triple jump. Sophomore **Kai Roper** did not start in the 200 meters after qualifying for the national meet. Frizzell also finished 11th in the shot put in front of junior teammate **Jaban Moore**, who finished 12th in the event.

Raithel takes national title; UCM has six All-American performances

(Walnut, Calif.) – Senior **Dan Raithel** capped six UCM All-American performances at the NCAA Division II Track and Field Championships with a national title in the hammer throw this weekend in Walnut, Calif.

His throw of 219-08 was tops while teammate **Jaban Moore** took seventh in the event with a toss of 186-10. The Central Missouri 4x100 relay team of **Dannon Abney**, **Damond Berry**, **Eric Moore**, and **Chris Leverette** grabbed seventh place with a time of 40.52. Freshman **Drew Frizzell** rounded out the Mules All-Americans with an eighth place mark in the shot put (54-08). As a team the Mules took 14th in the nation.
