Last Time Out:

Jennies volleyball captures St. Mary's Invitational

(San Antonio, Tx.) – Jennies volleyball captured the St. Mary's Invitational in San Antonio, Texas on Saturday with 3-0 match victories over Cameron University and Arkansas-Monticello. The Jennies opened up play on Friday with a 3-0 victory over Indiana (Pa.) and a 3-1 victory over host St. Mary's University.

In match one against Indiana (PA) the Jennies won 30-18, 30-14, 30-15, and were led by **Amber Yoder's** 13 kills. Freshman **Rachel Fister** and senior **Audrey Jensen** each had 11 digs as the Jens cruised.

In the Friday nightcap, the Jennies posted a 3-1 victory over St. Mary's University (30-22, 24-30, 30-19, 30-24), losing their only game of the weekend. Central Missouri was led with 16 kills by Fister and 13 kills by Yoder. Jensen picked up 23 digs in the match and **Caitlin Pankratz** logged a weekend-high 45 assists.

Saturday the Jennies took out Cameron 30-10, 30-21, 30-10. **Jillian Ohrman** and Yoder each led the way with 14 kills. Pankratz had 29 assists to go along with nine digs in the contest. Jensen led Central Missouri with 18 digs.

The Jennies finished the tournament on Saturday with a 3-0 victory over Arkansas-Monticello (30-19, 30-19, 30-22). Yoder had 12 kills and Andrea Robertson had 10 in the match. Jensen once again led the way in digs with 16.

The 12th ranked Jennies will be back in action next Friday and Saturday, Aug. 31-Sept. 1 at the Division II Premier Challenge in Denver, Colorado.

Pankratz named Tournament MVP

Sophomore setter **Caitlin Pankratz** was selected as the most valuable player and named to the all-tournament team last weekend at the St. Mary's Invitational in San Antonio, Tx. Pankratz recorded 144 assists, an 11.08 average per game over the weekend. The Buhler, Kansas native also collected 35 digs on the weekend.

Seniors **Audrey Jensen** and **Amber Yoder** were also selected to the squad. Jensen, a libero collected 68 digs on the weekend, along with seven service aces. Yoder, an outside hitter, collected four double-figure matches in kills. She had 52 total kills on the weekend and hit .423.

Jensen named MIAA Specialist of the Week for Volleyball

(WARRENSBURG, Mo.) – **Audrey Jensen**, a 5-foot-9 senior from Independence, Mo., averaged 5.23 digs and 0.954 service aces as the Jennies went 4-0 at the St. Mary's (Texas) Invitational.

She had 16 digs and four service aces in a 3-0 sweep of Arkansas-Monticello Saturday (Aug. 25), and logged 18 digs, one assist and an ace in three games vs. Cameron (Okla.). On day one Friday (Aug. 24), Jensen had 23 digs and a service ace in a 3-1 win over the host Lady Rattlers. She opened the tournament with 11 digs, three assists and an ace in a sweep of Indiana (Pa.).

Jensen, who logged a reception percentage of 93.2 (5 errors in 74 attempts) for the weekend, is a graduate of William Chrisman High School.

The Games: Jennies (4-0) will open pool play as one of 12 teams in four different pools on Friday against Augustana (S.D.) College (3-1) at the Division II Colorado Premeier Challenge in Denver, Colorado. The Jennies are in pool III which includes both Augustana (S.D.) and No.13 Chico State (3-1). Pool play for the Jennies will take place at Regis University. Tournament play will begin on Saturday September 1st. The tourney features eight schools that are rated in the pre-season Top 25 AVCA poll including No.2 Minnesota-Duluth.

Last Year at the Division II Premeier Challenge:The Jennies went an impressive 3-1 last year at the Division II Premier Challenge, with the only setback to No.4 Concordia (Minn.). Central Missouri posted wins over Regis, West Texas A&M and No.20 Abilene Christian.

Jennies History in the Division II Challenge:Since 1996, the Jennies have been playing in the Division II Premier Challenge in Denver, Colorado. The Jennies have posted an impressive 28-16 record in the highly competitive tournament. In 1996, the Jennies won the Challenge by going 4-0 with wins over North Dakota State, Regis University, Ferris State and Metropolitan State. The worst record the Jennies have finished with at the Challenge is a 2-2 record which has happened six times (1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2005). Central Missouri has finished with a 3-1 record four times (1997, 1998, 2004, 2006).

The Opponents: Augustana (S.D.) College

The Vikings (3-1) of the North Central Conference posted a 15-14 mark a year ago and tied for second in their conference. Head coach Kim Sudbeck enters her 13th season with a record of 267-110 overall. They went 3-1 last weekend at the Nova Southeastern Volleyball Classic with their only loss coming from No.16 Washburn. This will be the sixth time Central Missouri has played Augustana (S.D.) with the Vikings holding a 5-0 series advantage.

Chico State

The 13th ranked Wildcats of Chico State are coming off a 21-6 season and finished third in their conference a year ago. Chico State enters the Premier Challenge with a 3-1 record with a loss to Northwest Nazarene University. The Jennies will meet Chico State for the first time in school history.

Possible Opponents:

The Tournament features 12 schools in which nine are nationally ranked. Pool I features No.11 Grand Valley State (Mich.), No.25 Southwest Minnesota State and No.24 Lock Haven (Pa.). Pool II includes No.2 Minnesota-Duluth, No.17 Cal State-Los Angeles, and Regis University (Colo.). Pool III features **No.12 Central Missouri**, No.13 Chico State (Calif.), and Augustana (S.D.) College. Pool IV features No.14 West Texas A&M, Metro State (Colo.) and No.15 Southern Illinois-Edwards.

The Series:

Augustana (S.D.) College holds a 5-0 series advantage over Central Missouri. The Jennies will meet Chico State for the first time ever on Friday evening.

The Coaches:

Peggy Martin is in her 32nd year as head coach with a 1008-264-8 record. Under Martin's guidance, the Jennies have won at least 25 matches 28 straight seasons and have won or shared 19 MIAA crowns since the league began sponsoring the sport in 1982. Her teams have also made 24 NCAA Tournament appearances in a row, the most in Division II history, and have reached the "Elite Eight" six times, highlighted by a runner-up national showing in 1987.

Kim Sudbeck enters her 13th season with a career record of 267-110 for the Vikings. A year ago she led them to a second place finish in the North Central Conference.

Todd Caughlin is in his fifth year as head coach at Chico State. He guided the Wildcats to a 21-6 record in 2006 and a third place finish in the California Collegiate Athletic Association. He has managed to bring Chico State to a No.13 ranking this year.
