## Last Time Out:

### Jennies claim the Bentley Invitational

The sixth ranked Central Missouri volleyball squad (13-1) claimed the Bentley Invitational in Boston, Massachusetts this past weekend by knocking off Bryant University, host Bentley, New Haven, and C.W. Post. The Jens only dropped one game the entire weekend.

The Jennies opened up competition on Friday with a win over Bryant University 3-0 (30-13, 30-26, 30-22). Central Missouri was led with 13 kills by senior **Jillian Ohrman**. **Amber Yoder** also chipped in 11 kills for UCM. **Caitlin Pankratz** registered 35 assists in the match. **Carrie Peterson** led the Jennies with nine digs.

Central Missouri faced the host Bentley University in game two on Friday. The Jens took the match 3-0 (30-16, 30-17, 30-18). Ohrman led the way again in kills with 13, while Yoder had 11. **Audrey Jensen** continued her success on defense and registered 18 digs. Pankratz had 42 assists to go along with five digs.

The Jennies opened play Saturday with a 3-1 victory over New Haven (30-23, 26-30, 30-18, 30-23). Freshman **Rachel Fister** registered a double-double in the contest with 12 kills and 11 digs. Pankratz also registered a double-double for the Jens with 45 assists and 12 digs. Yoder had 17 kills and Ohrman had 12. Jensen led UCM in digs once again with 19.

Central Missouri wrapped up the Bentley Invitational with a 3-0 win over C.W. Post (30-20, 30-8, 30-13). Yoder registered her second game high of the weekend with 15 kills. Fister had 12 digs to go along with her eight kills. Pankratz led the way again in assists with 37. Jensen had 14 digs while Peterson added 10.

### Jensen named MVP, Yoder All-Tourney

Seniors **Audrey Jensen** and **Amber Yoder** were named to the Bentley Invitational All-Tournament Team this weekend. Jensen also garnered MVP honors for the tournament. On the weekend, Jensen had a total of 60 digs from her libero position while Yoder registered four double-figure matches in kills. August 31st. The Jennies have out killed their opponents on the year 761 to 626. Thats an average of 15.5 kills **a game to 12.8** for the opponents. UCM has also outblocked its opponents 122 to 71.

## The Numbers:

Central Missouri has an impressive 39-10 record in game play on the season and 13-1 record overall. There only match resulting in a loss was to No.13 Augustana (S.D.) College on August 31st. The Jennies have out killed their opponents on the year 761 to 626. Thats an average of 15.5 kills a game to 12.8 for the opponents. UCM has also outblocked its opponents 122 to 71.

Senior Outside Hitters **Jillian Ohrman** and **Amber Yoder** continue their success on the season. Yoder has registered 11 double figure games in kills while Ohrman has 10. Yoder also leads the squad in kills with 176 on the season, an average of 3.59 per game. Ohrman is not far behind with 169, an average of 3.52 per game. Ohrman also leads the Jens in hitting at .393, with Yoder second at .326. **Andrea Robertson** also has 132 kills on the season to rank third for UCM. She has registered double-figure kills seven times on the year.

**Caitlin Pankratz** is averaging 11.9 assists per game to give her 583 on the season to lead the team. **Audrey Jensen** leads the team in digs with 261 on the season, a 5.44 average per game. Out of 14 games on the year Jensen has had double-figure digs in 13 of them. Freshman **Rachel Fister** ranks second on the team in digs with 121 and fourth on the team in kills with 87. **Ashlei Jandrey** leads UCM in service aces with 26.

## The Games:

The No. 6 Jennies (13-1) will open up action this week with a non-conference matchup against Division II Missouri- St. Louis in St. Louis, Mo on Wednesday. Missouri St. Louis comes in with a 4-6 record on the year.

Central Missouri will be back at home on Friday for an MIAA conference match up against the Lady Bearcats of Southwest Baptist University. Southwest Baptist has a 5-8 record on the season. Last season the Jennies beat SBU 3-0 at home and then 3-1 on the road.

## The Opponents:

### University of Missouri-St. Louis

The Tritons of the Great Lakes Valley Conference boast a 4-6 record in 2007. Last year they finished with a 11-18 record. Head coach Josh Lauer enters his fourth year for Missouri-St. Louis. Central Missouri has a huge advantage as it leads the all-time series 43-1.

### Southwest Baptist University

The Lady Bearcats have started off the year with a 5-8 record. Last season SBU finished 5-29. This season they have already matched their win total under first year head coach Kelly Richardson. Top returnees for the Bearcats are outside hitter Kinsey Palmer, middle blocker Trish Hammerschmidt, and Setter Chelsea Kenney. UCM again has another huge advantage as they lead SBU in the all-time series 45-1.

## The Coaches:

**Peggy Martin** is in her 32nd year as head coach with a 1017-265-8 record. Under Martin's guidance, the Jennies have won at least 25 matches 28 straight seasons and have won or shared 19 MIAA crowns since the league began sponsoring the sport in 1982. Her teams have also made 24 NCAA Tournament appearances in a row, the most in Division II history, and have reached the "Elite Eight" six times, highlighted by a runner-up national showing in 1987.
