## The Games:

The No. 7 ranked Jennies (19-2) will have two matches this week starting with a non-conference matchup at Rockhurst on Tuesday. The Jens will then have a MIAA conference matchup against No. 13 Pittsburg State at home on Saturday.

## Last Time Out:

### No. 5 Jennies cruise to 3-0 win over Fort Hays

The fifth ranked University of Central Missouri Jennies cruised to a 3-0 win over Fort Hays State University Saturday afternoon at the UCM Multipurpose Building.

The Jennies (19-2, 6-1 MIAA) took the games 30-23, 30-19, and 30-22 to win the match. Central Missouri finished the day with three players in double-figure kills, while Fort Hays State (12-10, 0-6 MIAA) finished with one. The Jennies also hit .252 for the day, while Fort Hays hit .071.

**Rachel Fister's** double-double led the way for the Jens with 13 kills and 11 digs. **Amber Yoder** and **Jillian Ohrman** also chipped in 12 and 11 kills respectively. **Audrey Jensen** had a match-high 17 digs, while **Caitlin Pankratz** had a match-high 41 assists. **Ashlei Jandrey** also had a double-figure match in digs with 10.

### No. 5 Jennies streaked snapped by No. 8 Bulldogs

The fifth ranked University of Central Missouri Jennies 14-game win streak was snapped on Wednesday night as they fell to No. 8 Truman State by a 3-1 margin at the UCM Multipurpose Building.

The Bulldogs (16-3, 4-0 MIAA) and Jennies (18-2, 5-1 MIAA) were neck and neck in game one before a spurt at the end gave Truman the 30-27 win. The second game was all Central Missouri from start to finish as it doubled up the Bulldogs early and never let up on the way to a 30-17 romp. TSU used spurts midway though the final two games and pulled away for 30-21 and 30-22 scores to clinch the match.

Central Missouri finished the night with four players in double-figure kills but committed 30 errors, compared to the Bulldogs' 19 miscues to drop the match. The Bulldogs also hit more than .300 in the final two games while UCM was never better than .208 in either.

**Rachel Fister** led the way with 17 kills while **Audrey Jensen** picked up 30 digs on the night. **Caitlin Pankratz** dished out a match-high 54 assists as well.

## MIAA In The Rankings:

The MIAA conference currently has five teams rated in the AVCA Top 25 National Poll. No. 5 Washburn and No. 6 Truman State jumped ahead of No. 7 Central Missouri after the Jennies dropped a 3-1 decision to the Bulldogs last week. Other teams from the MIAA in the Top 25 are No. 13 Pittsburg State and No. 23 Emporia State.

## The Opponents:

### Rockhurst University

Rockhurst comes into Tuesday's match with a 13-5 overall record. The Lady Hawks also boast a 5-3 record in the Great Lakes Valley Conference in 2007. Last season Rockhurst dropped a match 3-1 at Central Missouri.

Rockhurst is led by Rachel Fowler's 223 kills, an average of 3.43 a game. Audrey Boese is second on the team with 203 kills, an average of 3.12 a game. Amanda Hydorn is averaging 9.52 assists per game. Leading the Lady Hawks in digs is Andrea Schroeder with 4.49 a game.

Central Missouri has won the last four meetings between the two teams. Rockhurst's last win against the Jennies came by a 3-1 margin in 2002. UCM holds the all-time series advantage 9-to-5.

### Pittsburg State

No. 13 Pittsburg State comes into the week with a 17-4 overall record and 3-3 in the MIAA. They are coming off a close 3-2 loss to No. 8 Truman State. Last season UCM won a home contest 3-1 and then won on the road 3-0.

Pittsburg State is led by All-MIAA performers Sammie Williams and Pamela Cartagena. Williams is averaging 3.90 kills per game, while Cartagena is averaging 3.44. Ashlee Maple is leading Pittsburg State with 5.94 digs per game. Cartagena is also second on the Gorillas in digs with an average of 4.79 a game. Senior setter Sarah Brannock leads Pittsburg State in assists with an average of 7.39 a game.

Central Missouri has won its last eight meetings against the Gorillas. The Jennies last loss to the Gorillas came in 2003 on a 3-0 loss in the MIAA Tournament. In 2003, the Gorillas and Jennies played four times with each team winning twice. Central Missouri holds the all-time series advantage 42-2-1.

## The Coaches:

**Peggy Martin** is in her 32nd year as head coach with a 1023-266-8 record. Under Martin's guidance, the Jennies have won at least 25 matches 28 straight seasons and have won or shared 19 MIAA crowns since the league began sponsoring the sport in 1982. Her teams have also made 24 NCAA Tournament appearances in a row, the most in Division II history, and have reached the "Elite Eight" six times, highlighted by a runner-up national showing in 1987.

**Tracy Rietzke** is in his 20th season as head coach at Rockhurst University. He has compiled a 775-119 record in his career at Rockhurst and a 947-175 in his overall career of 25 years. He has managed to take the Lady Hawks to the post season 13 times. He currently ranks second behind **Peggy Martin** in all-time NCAA volleyball victories with 947. Last season he guided the Lady Hawks to a 26-5 record, including a second place finish in the Great Lakes Valley Conference.
