Spring Faculty Research Day at Central

CALL FOR PAPERS AND PRESENTATIONS

The Center for Teaching and Learning, in order to celebrate faculty scholarship at Central Missouri, calls for submission of original research papers during the Ninth Annual Faculty Research Day. A reception will be held on April 16th, 2013. There will be no public reading or presentation of papers, however ranked authors will be given a brief moment to summarize their work. Papers should conform to one of the following categories:

- Science, Technology, and Mathematics
- Social Sciences, Communications, and the Humanities
- Business, Economics, and Finance
- Education and Health and Human Services
- Instructional Technology, Community Engaged Scholarship, & Scholarship of Teaching and Learning

Submissions should be emailed to Melissa Wilson, mewilson@ucmo.edu, in electronic version no later than the close of working hours, Monday, March 4th, 2013. Submissions will be reviewed by faculty panels selected by the CTL.

Awards

The author of the first ranked paper selected in each category will be honored at a reception on April 16th, 2013, and receive an award of \$500.

The author of the second ranked paper in each category will also be recognized and receive an award of \$250.

Guidelines for Submissions of Papers Faculty Research Day, April 16th, 2013

- Papers must reflect research in one of following categories and be submitted for that category:
 - Science, Technology, and Mathematics
 - Social Sciences, Communications, and the Humanities
 - Business, Economics, and Finance
 - Education and Health and Human services
 - Instructional Technology, Community Engaged Scholarship, and Scholarship of Teaching and Learning

This project is limited to scholarly papers, including those in the fine arts and humanities, and no works of art, video or films, portfolios, literary works, reviews, or other exclusively creative works will be considered for inclusion; the CTL and its various faculty committees value such works and recognize them as scholarly endeavors and continue to explore a separate presentation and recognition event for productions of this nature by Central scholars.

- All entries must be submitted electronically to mewilson@ucmo.edu by Monday, March 4th, 2013.
- Those submitting papers must select the category for which they are submitting their papers; the selection will be final and no attempt will be made by the CTL or faculty readers to redirect the paper to another more appropriate category.
- Multi-authored papers must be submitted by a UCM researcher and the UCM faculty member must be the primary author.
- > All papers must be based upon the original research of the faculty author(s).
- Submissions may include papers submitted to or presented or published in other venues in the twelve months immediately preceding April 16th, 2013, as well as previously unpublished work.
- ➤ Each paper must be accompanied by an abstract numbering no more than 350 words.
- Neither the Center for Teaching and Learning nor the University of Central Missouri will make any claim to intellectual property rights for submissions receiving awards or electronically published.
- Papers may not exceed twenty-five typed pages in length; graphs, tables, or references may be added as appendixes.

- Submissions should follow publication guidelines required by scholarly journals in the presenter's discipline; however, for consideration, all papers should be double spaced and printed in Times New Roman, 12 point font.
- Each paper will be read and evaluated by a team of at least two faculty readers.
- Should a category not receive submissions or only receive one submission, the category will be cancelled.
- > Authors may apply to read but will not be assigned to read papers in the category to which their paper is judged.
- The faculty readers will submit to the CTL comments to be provided anonymously to authors to aid in improving the quality of papers for future publication.
- > The author of the highest ranked paper in each category will receive an award of \$500; the author of the second ranked paper in each category will receive an award of \$250. In the event of multiple authors, the award money will be evenly divided.
