

HOUSING & GREEK STUDENTS ARE WHO'S WHO NOMINEES

WARRENSBURG, MO – The Office of University Housing wish to recognize Adam Dustman the recipient of the Charno Award as well as senior housing and Greek students who were named as Who's Who of the University of Central Missouri. Out of the 30 students nominated, ten of the students were Greek and six of the students served as residence hall leaders.

Each year the university recognizes a small number of students from the senior class for their outstanding achievements.
