IN-PERSON in 2022

We will be following public health protocols. Currently, that means occupancy of any campus facility is limited to 75% of normal capacity. In addition, we will schedule down time between performances to allow for aerosols from instruments to dissipate.

Introduction

This year at the UCM Jazz Festival we plan to have between 30-50 middle and high school jazz groups participating in the festival. They will come from classes 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 as designated by MSHSAA regulations, as well as middle school/junior high, and will receive constructive comments (recorded digitally and emailed to directors), rating sheets, and some individual time with our judges (as programming allows).

The festival will run approximately 8:00 AM-6:00 PM. There will be a concert featuring some of our adjudicators performing with UCM's jazz ensembles, along with the presentation of individual awards and "I" rating plaques (see below) at the end of the day (approximately 5:30 PM - 6:30 PM).

Please note: we will continue using a RATINGS ONLY format for the festival this year (non-competitive only). All groups receiving a "I" rating will receive a trophy/plaque. It is our hope to make the festival as positive and educational an experience as possible. For any additional questions, please contact:

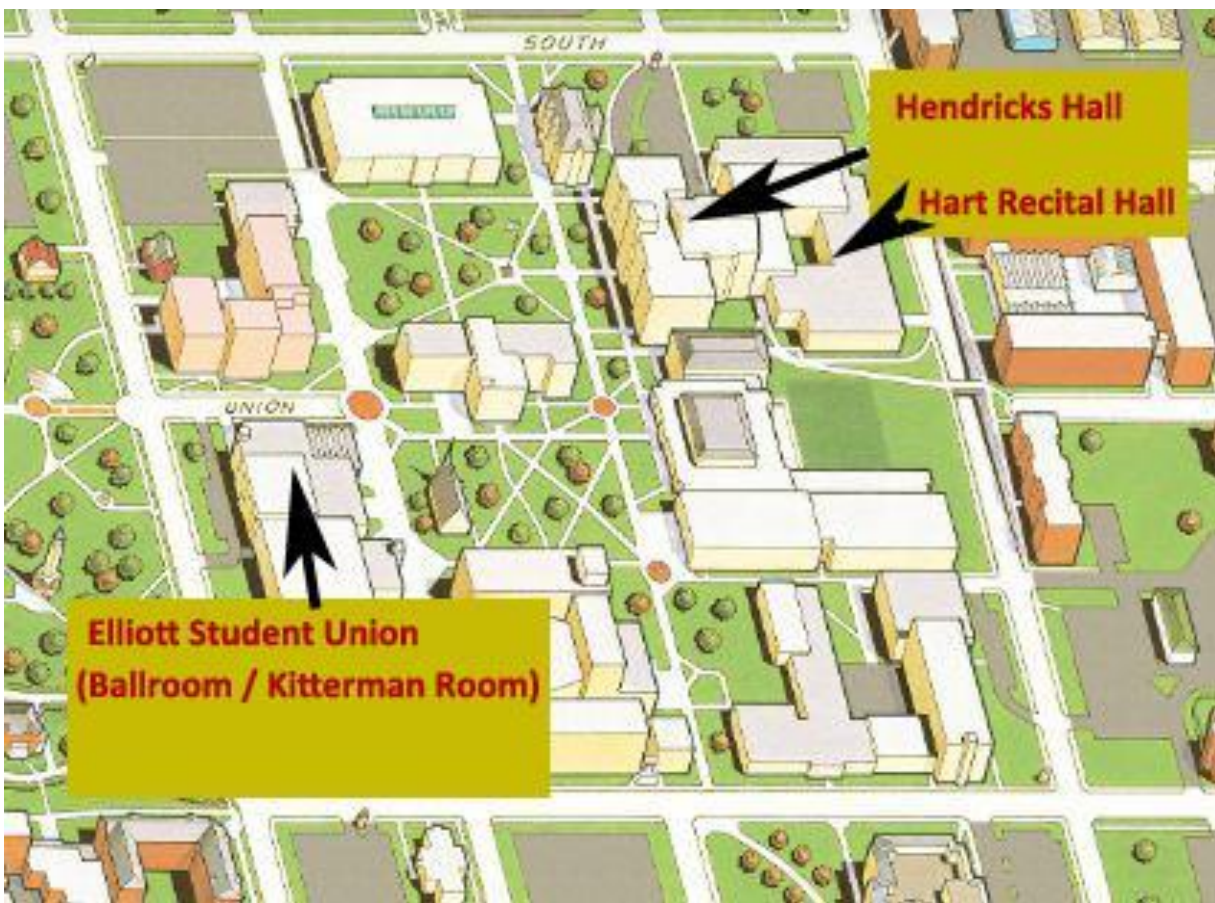

Adjudicators

Adjudicators at the UCM Jazz Festival provide evaluation of the participating jazz bands and combos in three formats:

1. **Audio Evaluation:** Adjudicators record comments throughout the ensembles' performances using digital recorders. Each participating director will receive a unique folder link to download audio (or listen directly from the web) from www.dropox.com. Contact the Festival Director if the unique link is misplaced.
2. **Written Evaluation:** Adjudicators will make minimal written comments as time permits, using the UCM Jazz Festival evaluation forms (samples).

3. **Ensemble Clinic:** As time permits, adjudicators will clinic ensembles following their performances. Ensembles that choose to play for their entire allotted performance time, will receive little to no clinic time.
