Course options may include content in PK-12 school librarianship, collaborative planning, instruction in multiple literacies, inquiry-based learning, trends in children's and young adult literature, ethical and equitable access, library program advocacy, library programs, resources, and services

Core Courses (21 credits)

Courses will include instruction in Leadership Development, Foundations of P-20 Education, Development of Learners, Educational Entrepreneurism, Leadership & Ethics in a Diverse Society, Organizational Leadership, and Institutional Research, Assessment, & Accreditation

Dissertation Courses (9 credits)

Three courses strategically placed throughout the 2-year program.

Students will work together in a cohort model over two years (Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters) to complete the degree. Courses will be online or via internet communication.
