

ADDENDUM MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BLUE SPRINGS SCHOOL DISTRICT and UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL MISSOURI

This addendum is between the University of Central Missouri (UCM) and the Blue Springs School District (BSSD). UCM and BSSD entered into a certain Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), with an effective date of April 18, 2023. UCM and BSSD agree to amend the agreement with the following changes.

Change the description of the Memorandum of Understanding to use the words program of study replacing the word options. See revised language below.

Candidates may select from three Programs of Study: Teacher Leadership; Literacy & Coaching; and Curriculum & Instruction.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes the coordination of activities between the University of Central Missouri (UCM) and the Blue Springs School District (BSSD) in cooperatively offering a series of for credit courses towards an Education Specialist Degree in Professional Leadership with three options: Teacher Leadership; Literacy & Coaching; and Curriculum & Instruction.

UCM and Blue Springs School District will provide a series of for credit courses based on the degree options listed above. Additionally, UCM and the Blue Springs School District has agreed to provide the prerequisite course CTE 5900: Research Methods for CTE 5910 or CTE 6100.

- Courses listed above will be taught in online and hybrid modalities. If delivered onsite, courses will occur at a mutually agreed upon location within the Blue Springs School District.
- Courses taught for the cohort identified by UCM will be billed at \$235.00 per credit hour.



- Some courses, if needed, may be taught by Blue Springs School District employees meeting minimum UCM faculty qualifications and will be hired as adjunct instructors.
- If needed, BSSD will identify qualified staff to teach the online and hybrid courses and UCM will pay them \$700 per credit hour if they have a master's degree or \$900 if the instructor holds specialist/doctorate degree. If the Blue Springs School District wishes to use additional instructors for a class, any compensation for those additional instructors will be provided by the Blue Springs School District. If the lead instructor is a full-time UCM faculty member and the cohort class is taught out of load, the UCM faculty member will receive no load credit for the cohort class and will be paid a stipend at the adjunct pay rate.
- Blue Springs School District will identify teachers eligible for the program and pay UCM directly for the course enrollment.
- Students/teachers are expected to enroll in an average six (6) credit hours each semester unless otherwise directed to by the faculty liaison.
- Students/teachers must meet the minimum qualifications for admission to UCM's Graduate Studies and the academic program as outlined below. Students will incur a \$30 application fee.
 - A 2.5 minimum bachelor's GPA
- BBSD will assist in the recruitment of a cohort of teachers that wish to enroll in the abovementioned courses.
- This MOU will stay in effect for a total of seven semesters ending Summer 2025.
