

CROSS-TOWN AGREEMENT

This agreement is among the governing authorities the Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of the University of Missouri-Columbia which hosts Air Force ROTC, the governing authorities of University of Central Missouri which does not host an Air Force ROTC unit, and Commander, Aerospace Studies/Air Force ROTC. It is the purpose of this agreement to make the Air Force ROTC course available to qualified students of University of Central Missouri who desire to earn appointments as commissioned officers in the United States Air Force.

AGREEMENT

1. Contingent upon acceptance of this agreement and upon the initial and continuing fulfillment of all the conditions enumerated in paragraphs 2, 3, 4 and 5 following, the Air Force Commander will:
 - a. Provide Air Force ROTC instruction in the military course to qualified and selected applicants who are students of the University of Central Missouri. Air Force ROTC instruction will be provided to those selected students of University of Central Missouri on the campus of University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - b. Enroll qualified students of University of Central Missouri who are selected for Aerospace Studies as members of the Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - c. Provide uniforms, in accordance with the existing agreement or any subsequent agreements entered into between University of Missouri-Columbia and the Uniform Manager of Aerospace Studies/Air Force ROTC, to University of Missouri-Columbia for all Air Force ROTC cadets who are enrolled as members of the Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - d. Provide subsistence allowance in accordance with existing policies to all Air Force ROTC cadets who are members of the Aerospace Studies/Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - i. To University of Missouri-Columbia for all Air Force ROTC cadets on scholarship status who are enrolled as members of the Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - ii. To University of Central Missouri for all Air Force ROTC cadets on scholarship status who are enrolled as members of the Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia if a separate education service agreement exists between the Department of the Air Force and University of Central Missouri.
2. Contingent upon the acceptance of this agreement and upon fulfillment of the conditions enumerated in paragraph 1 above, the governing authority of University of Missouri-Columbia agree to:
 - i. Furnish necessary uniforms and accessories to all enrolled members of the Air Force ROTC unit which it hosts as agreed by University of Missouri-Columbia and Air Force ROTC.
 - ii. Provide adequate classroom and related administrative facilities to support the aerospace studies instruction of all enrolled members of its Air Force ROTC unit who received instruction on its campus, including students from the University of Central Missouri.
 - iii. Report estimated and actual costs of tuition and fees for each fiscal year to the Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia. This report will be the basis for funding obligations for each fiscal year.
3. Contingent upon the acceptance of this agreement and upon fulfillment of the conditions enumerated in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, the governing authorities of University of Central Missouri agree to:
 - i. Include in appropriate publications announcement of the aerospace studies course of Air Force ROTC available to students.
 - ii. Require All University of Central Missouri students participating in the Air Force ROTC cross town agreement must apply to the University of Missouri as non-degree visiting students.

- iii. Require All University of Central Missouri students participating in the program must enroll into the cross-town course(s) at the University of Missouri prior to the last day to enroll for the term at the University of Missouri.
 - iv. Accept that Courses taken and grades earned under this agreement between the University of Central Missouri and the University of Missouri are not included on the MU transcript as credit is awarded by the University of Central Missouri.
 - v. Accept that All grades for students participating in the Air Force ROTC program are entered into the University of Central Missouri student information system by an authorized University of Missouri ROTC staff member in a secure manner and in accordance with FERPA guidelines.
 - vi. Require All University of Central Missouri students participating under the cross-town agreement will abide by all University of Missouri policies (academic, standard of conduct etc.) and required training (Title IX, Student Health, Citizenship, Alcohol Education, etc.)
 - vii. Grant appropriate academic credit applicable toward graduation for the successful completion of courses offered by the Department of Aerospace Studies at University of Missouri-Columbia.
 - viii. Report if a separate education services agreement exists between the Aerospace Studies/Air Force ROTC and University of Central Missouri, the estimated cost of tuition and fees for each fiscal year to the Air Force ROTC detachment at University of Missouri-Columbia. This report will be the basis for funding obligations for each fiscal year.
4. The governing authorities of University of Missouri, and University of Missouri-Columbia Air Force ROTC program will transfer tuition and fees received to University of Central Missouri for those students on scholarship status from University of Central Missouri enrolled in Air Force ROTC at University of Missouri-Columbia less the tuition and fees for course taken at University of Missouri- Columbia.
- a. University of Central Missouri student not completing the program will need to repay the scholarship money. University of Central Missouri will be responsible for collecting scholarship money and reimbursing University of Missouri-Columbia for tuition and fees.
5. The governing authorities of University of Central Missouri affirm that:
- a. The following regional association accredits it (as a baccalaureate degree granting institution): Higher Learning Commission
 - b. For good and valid mutual consideration, and as a condition precedent to acceptance and discrimination in any way with respect to the admission or subsequent treatment of students on the basis of race, color, sex, or national origin. It is further mutually agreed that Cadet Command may regard a violation of this covenant, as breach of the agreement, justifying termination thereof, at no cost to the government.
6. All parties agree that:
- a. This agreement becomes effective upon execution of all signatories.
 - b. This agreement may be terminated at the end of any school year by any of the parties hereto by giving six (6) months prior notice of such intent to both other parties.
