CHARNO AWARDS

The Charno Award is presented annually to the top male and female citizens of the University of Central Missouri. The honor is named after George Charno, Sr., a Kansas City attorney who established the award in 1940 to recognize the two outstanding members of the senior class. Selection is based on a combination of criteria, which include: leadership, scholarship, character, involvement in campus organizations and extracurricular activities, service to the university, and involvement in one's academic department. Announced during the Spring 2021 semester, this year's recipients are Zachary Racy and Olivia Waddell.



ZACHARY RACY

Zachary Racy, called "Zac" by his friends at UCM, is a resident of Riverside, Missouri, who is graduating summa cum laude with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from UCM, where he gained experience in many areas that have a direct impact on students. He was the student representative on the university's Board of Governors, a position he assumed after his work with the Student Government Association. Since 2019, he has donated his time to opportunities that include serving as a senator, floor leader and member of SGA's University Issues Committee. He has volunteered as public relations chair for the Honors College Student Association, and served as vice president of finance and records for the

Intrafraternity Council. Zac also was president of the Service Team in the Integrated Business Experience Program, which offers real-life experience to students in developing and marketing products.

While assisting outside groups such as Big Brothers Big Sisters, Zac's campus involvement includes serving as a member the Mule Nation Student Chapter, alumni ambassador, and member of Sigma Tau Gamma fraternity. He has been active in Student Experience and Engagement activities such as serving as an Impact Student Leadership Retreat keynote speaker and Mule Team leader, and participating as a student speaker for the Week of Welcome Kickoff events. He worked as a student employee in the Office of the President and at the Pertle Springs golf course.

Coming to UCM from Olathe, Kansas, Olivia Waddell is graduating summa cum laude after earning a Bachelor of Social Work and a Bachelor of Arts in International Studies. Her experience at UCM allowed her to develop leadership skills through opportunities such as vice president of membership and alumnae relations chair with Delta Zeta sorority, and as a former president of Rho Lambda and vice president of accountability for the Panhellenic Executive Council. This is in addition to involvement with the Conversation Partner Program through the UCM English Language Institute and Center for Global Education, and membership with the Global Ambassadors.

Olivia has served as student ambassador and freshman orientation leader for UCM's Admissions Office and engaged in community service during annual homecoming celebrations and Greek Week, while also joining with her sorority sisters to assist organizations and programs such as Ronald McDonald House, Art Bra KC, and the Cinderella Dress Exchange. She worked on a service trip with survivors of sex trafficking in the Philippines, was a volunteer for Integrity Homecare and Hospice doing bereavement and wellness visits, and assisted with Warrensburg Project Community Connect, which aids local families in need. In addition to serving as a community advisor and an office assistant for University Housing, she was the recipient of grants that enabled her do research related to the Middle East, and in 2018 she participated in a Study Abroad Trip to Jordan and Israel.

2021 BYLER DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARD

Named after William H. Byler, an inventor, author and teacher who graduated from UCM in 1927, the Byler Distinguished Faculty Award is the highest recognition bestowed upon UCM faculty members. Byler established an endowment fund to provide annual recognition for distinguished faculty performance, evidenced by teaching, scholarly, or creative activity, and professional service. This year's recipient is Dr. Frances (Fran) Reddington, professor and director of the Criminal Justice Institute in the Department of Criminal Justice and Criminology.

Dr. Fran Reddington joined UCM in 1992 as an assistant professor in the Department of Criminal Justice and climbed the faculty ranks to become a professor in 2001. She was named to her current post in 2015, where she serves among faculty in the Harmon College of Business and Professional Studies.

In supporting Dr. Reddington's nomination for the Byler Distinguished Faculty Award, her colleagues praised her work inside and outside the classroom, citing outstanding traits that include her dedication to the success of both students and other criminal justice and criminology faculty. They noted

Dr. Reddington is one of the most supportive and collegial faculty members in her academic school. She not only strives to prepare the best materials for her own class, but she shares them with colleagues so they are not required to "reinvent the wheel." Students have noted that she not only has the ability to energize them and get them excited about course material, but

some describe her as "a favorite" and "awesome teacher" in the way she enriches their learning environment.

Dr. Reddington produces high-quality scholarship that informs policy and practice, and ensures she is working with students and junior faculty for their long-term success. She also serves the UCM campus on committees and work groups, and through her connections outside of campus looks for ways to provide real solutions for juveniles and criminal justice professionals across the state and nation.

To help meet strong student interest, Dr. Reddington developed a proposal for a Criminal Justice and Criminology minor in Juvenile Justice, with input from the director of Child and Family Development. This program was implemented in 2017.

Throughout her tenure, Dr. Reddington has consistently strived for excellence and innovative approaches to teaching. Within her academic area, she has been a leader in online instruction since the Criminal Justice program became the first on campus to be offered 100 percent online 15 years ago.

Demonstrating her belief that education continues outside the classroom, she helped launch the nation's first student chapter of the American Correctional Association (ACA), and served as an advisor to that organization for more than a decade. She has taken students to multiple state, regional, and national conferences and has helped oversee countless hours of community service. Dr. Reddington has also arranged for multiple student tours of a Division of Youth Services facility in Waverly, Missouri, a juvenile detention center, the Henry County jail, and a juvenile court, just to name a few.

2020 BYLER DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARD

Dr. Dawna Lisa (Buchanan) Butterfield, professor of literacy education and English language learning, was the Spring 2020 recipient of the Byler Distinguished Faculty Award. The 2020 Spring Commencement ceremony was canceled due to the pandemic. UCM is pleased to publicly recognize her today.

Dr. Dawna Lisa (Buchanan) Butterfield is a UCM faculty member who has demonstrated outstanding achievement over a long, sustained period of time as a professor of literacy education and English language learning in the School of Teaching and Learning. Her colleagues say she embodies the true spirit of faculty service through her experiences in intensive graduate advising, leadership for a student organization, and contributions made to the institution through service on committees at the university, college and departmental levels. She is also recognized as a "great model for faculty service" possessing characteristics related to student mentorship and instruction that led to previous honors such as the Excellence in Teaching and Distinguished Faculty Awards in the College of Education, as well as the Missouri Governor's Award for Excellence in Education in 2015.

After growing up in Canada, Dr. Butterfield has enjoyed a career in education that spans more than 30 years, including nearly 25 years spent at UCM. In addition to devoting much of her time serving in the classroom, for approximately five years, beginning in 2012, she served as chair of the Department of Educational Foundations and Literacy, and coordinated the Literacy Education program. To pursue her longstanding passion for teaching, she returned to the classroom where her major assignments continue to be in literacy education.

Throughout her tenure at UCM, Dr. Butterfield has been a strong advocate for a program that helps teach students who want to serve in the classroom how to instruct K-12 students who are learning to speak English. Her work in this area has included developing and designing a new introductory course on English Language Learners and Culturally Responsive Pedagogy to meet new Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education requirements across all teacher education programs.

Dr. Butterfield has always demonstrated a strong commitment to engaged learning and future-focused academics. This is evident through previous work that included design and revision of online courses and through training in Quality Matters online design, which provided her knowledge of best practices in online course development. She was active in developing a new Educational Foundations Core, which was adopted by the College of Education Teacher Education Council in 2014.

In addition to her record of scholastic work that includes research and publications, she has helped foster a culture of service at UCM through her volunteerism. This includes participation in the annual Children's Literature Festival which brings thousands of young people and their teachers to campus, and establishing a student group, Leading Educator Advocates for Diversity (LEAD), which resulted in a scholarship for students who provide outstanding community service.

GOVERNOR'S AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

The Governor's Award for Excellence in Education is an annual recognition initiative established by the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education. In recognizing honorees, the awards program considers criteria such as effective teaching, effective advising, innovative course design and delivery, service to the university community, commitment to high standards of excellence and success in nurturing student achievement. This year's award goes to a faculty member in the College of Education, Dr. Julie Hentges.

Dr. Julie Hentges is s a professor of education who serves as program coordinator for the Masters of Science in Education (MSE) Elementary Education/Curriculum and Instruction program and faculty advisor to Kappa Delta Pi (KDP) education honor society at UCM. A dedicated educator for more than two decades and a self-proclaimed lifelong learner, Dr. Hentges today is helping to ignite the same passion she shares for education with her undergraduate and graduate students in the College of Education.

Colleagues who supported Dr. Hentges' nomination cited qualities such as her dedication to the field of education, implementation of high-quality teaching practices, professional scholarship and ongoing service among many reasons she deserves this recognition. They noted that her desire to model effective teaching practices and produce great teacher candidates drives her efforts to consistently monitor student progress, implement innovative strategies, reexamine assessment tools, and participate in professional development events.

Dr. Hentges' students have cited outstanding professional characteristics such as her ability to create valuable relationships with them while also instilling a wealth of knowledge, providing meaningful assignments, and valuable feedback. Students also say she always makes herself available to help them, and that she has a genuine interest in their success.

Dr. Hentges is described as innovative in her approach to curriculum development, having worked to revise multiple courses in her area to bring them into alignment with new professional standards. While doing so, she has increased the rigor and expectations for her students to achieve excellence, which are important considerations for continued accreditation of programs.

Dr. Hentges has an outstanding record of service to UCM. This has included serving as chair of the College and the School Promotion and Tenure committees, as well as service as a member of the College Assembly Executive Committee. She works to create a community of learners, both inside and outside the classroom, and she encages students in service. For example, in her role this academic year as student organization advisor to Kappa Delta Pi., she and her students initiated the "We are ALL in this together" T-shirt sales fundraiser to benefit the Campus Cupboard. She also provides leadership for KDP's Freshman Mentor Program, which helps acclimate students to their university major while connecting them with peers.

Throughout her service to UCM, which began more than a decade ago, Dr. Hentges has earned a number of special honors. Most recently, this has included the Learning to a Greater Degree Award, the College of Education's Excellence in Teaching Award, Kappa Delta Pi Excellence in Education Award, and the UCM Advisor of the Year Award.

THE PRESIDENTIAL MEDALLION

The University of Central Missouri's Presidential Medallion was introduced during the inauguration ceremony for UCM's 16th president Dr. Roger J. Best on April 18, 2019. Designed by staff in the Office of Integrated Marketing and Communications, the nickel silver, antique finish medallion features as the central focal piece, a three-inch in diameter round medal that includes the university's academic logo with

the year of the institution's founding in 1871, and the motto "Education for Service." Other components include two 1.5-inch diameter university seals, and curved banners that are linked together and list the names of each university president who served the institution since its founding and their years of service. The medallion is to be worn at ceremonial functions, including commencement ceremonies.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The University Mace was designed and produced for the inauguration of Dr. Ed Elliott as president in 1985.

As a historical note, maces were first used during Roman times. The first mace was a weapon-like staff, composed of a group of reeds surrounding an axe. Mace bearers would walk in front of the person in authority. Maces were later used in England, again as symbols of authority in the court systems. The staff was carried by a judge or transported for him by a mace bearer. As the American court system developed from the English courts, the mace also became a symbol of authority in America.

The University of Central Missouri's mace is made of native walnut and bronze, and is topped with a somewhat stylized flame, which, like light, stands for truth and knowledge. Beneath the flame are inlaid disks of cardinal and black, the university colors. Continuing down the mace, a large sphere is decorated with carvings of major buildings on campus. Holding the ball are simple finger-like formations, which stand for service. The reeding, or half-columns, on the mace symbolizes tradition in education and togetherness - small parts working together to support the whole. Bronze books and mortarboards with tassels are symbols of academia and education, and bronze casts of Missouri represent UCM's home state and the citizens it serves. The handle of the mace is spiraled, which denotes growth and progression. The mace, completed with a hand-rubbed oil finish, weighs approximately 14 pounds.

The base for the staff is bronze and weighs close to 20 pounds. It is adorned with centennial medallions and Missouri mules in harness, denoting the reliable, workaday university mascot.

When not used for ceremonial purposes, the mace stands in its base in the Office of the President. The University Mace is carried at ceremonial functions by the university marshal, who precedes the university president in the processional. By tradition at the University of Central Missouri, the university marshal is the president of the Faculty Senate.

The construction of the mace was a team effort. Board of Regents member Edna Mae Whitsitt contacted Rich Monson of the Art Department for design assistance. Monson developed several designs, and a committee consisting of Ophelia Gilbert, Alice Gower, Monson, Norma Van Zee, and Whitsitt selected the design to be used. Jack Landers, faculty member in the Department of Manufacturing and Construction, built the walnut core of the mace. Monson and Richard Allman, Art Department, cast and assembled the bronze pieces. Robert Tompkins, Department of Physical Education, carved the frieze, and Joseph Albrecht, Manufacturing and Construction, fashioned a bronze stem to join a base that was cast by Monson and George Sample, Art Department. Additional assistance was provided by art faculty members Jerry Miller, Harold Reynolds and Billi Rothove.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

Academic regalia of robe and hood are believed to have had their beginnings at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the 12th and 13th centuries. The hoods are a carryover from the times when the monks, who operated the universities, wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter or to collect alms when worn as shoulder capes.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in 1754 with the founding of what is now Columbia University. In 1895, a commission of university officials adopted a universal code of design and color for academic garb. It has undergone various revisions, the latest in 1960. Styling of robes varies for the bachelor's, master's, education specialist and doctoral degrees and the width of border and length of hood increase with the type of degree. The color of the velvet border of the hood indicates the field of study, while the lining designates

the colors of the institution granting the degree. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is worn closed. The gown for the master's degree and the education specialist degree has an oblong sleeve, open at the wrist with the rear part of its oblong shape square cut and the front part with an arc cutaway. It may be worn open or closed.

The doctoral gown is faced with black velvet and has three bars across the bell-shaped sleeves. These facings and crossbars may be of colored velvet to represent the degree, and agree in color with the binding or edging of the hood. The tassel for the cap may be of gold thread.

THE HONORS COLLEGE

Students in The Honors College engage in high-impact learning in a collegial environment that adds significant value to their academic and social experience at UCM. Specifically, Honors College students pursue a rigorous course of study that includes small-sized, honors-only general education courses and interdisciplinary colloquia, as well as a minimum of two semesters of a foreign language. All Honors College students are also required to collaborate closely with a faculty mentor on a capstone undergraduate research or creative project in their respective areas of academic expertise. The second oldest program of its kind west of the Mississippi, UCM's Honors College program began in 1958 with just 12 students. Today's graduates of The Honors College thus become part of a long tradition of education for excellence and service at the University of Central Missouri.
