This application is for students who are unable to participate in the commencement ceremony of their degree completion term (who graduated prior to May 2022) and would like to participate in a later commencement ceremony (only through May 2022). For example, if you complete your degree in December 2021, you are eligible to "walk late" in May 2022 and no later. Students who will graduate in May 2022 must participate in a May 2022 ceremony and will not be afforded the opportunity to participate in a future commencement ceremony.

This application will only be accepted for students who have already applied for and been approved for graduation. If you have not yet applied for graduation, please do so first. It will take 1-2 weeks to receive the review of your graduation application. After you have received the results of your graduation application you may proceed with this application.

Students are charged a non-refundable \$50 "walk late" fee. This fee is in addition to regular graduation fees (\$50 during the term of your graduation) and the \$25 hood fee (for graduate students only). However, the "walk late" fees will not be imposed during Fall 2021 due to COVID-19. LATE WALK FEES WILL BE IMPOSED FOR THE MAY 2022 CEREMONIES.

UCM offers two commencement ceremonies per year, May and December. Per UCM policy, students are invited to participate in the graduation ceremony offered at the end of their last term of coursework. Students graduating in the summer semester are included in the previous spring commencement ceremony.
