HOMECOMING 2022 Rules & Regulations - Blood Drive

The Blood Drive is an opportunity for students, faculty, staff and the community to give back to others by donating blood. The Blood Drive is sponsored by The Community Blood Center out of Kansas City, MO.

Rules:

1. Individuals are eligible to donate blood if they meet the Community Blood Center medical requirements.

2. Each organization that wishes to compete for placement must pre-register on the Homecoming registration day, Sept. 23, 2022.

3. Credit is given per <u>donor</u> for the organization of their choice. *<u>Credit will be given to donors</u> <u>who donate blood at the donation site</u>. Donors who give on the ALYX machine will also receive credit per <u>donor</u>.

4. <u>ALL</u> deferred donors must <u>show</u> and <u>turn in</u> their Registration Paperwork, to the Homecoming Table, before being awarded their credit for donating. *This registration paperwork must have Vitals on it and a Signature from the Community Blood Drive Staff.*

5. In addition, if someone is unable to give, then they may find someone to give on their behalf. Donations will be accepted by the organization's members, friends, family or donors that are willing to give on the organizations behalf.

6. Solicitation of participants is welcomed to recruit donors, but not within the Union.

7. Placement will be awarded to registered organizations according to the number of donations/credits that each group receives. There will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

8. Any Violation of the Community Blood Center's rules and/or the Homecoming Rules will result in your organization's disqualification from this event.
