- 1. Organizations must register each participating member for service day Online
 - (ucmo.edu/homecoming/schedule), then click on Community Service Project, by Wednesday,

September 18, 2019 by 5:00 p.m.

2. In order for the participating organization to receive their points, the entire number of registered

volunteers <u>MUST SHOW</u> up on their assigned day of service at their assigned time.

- 3. If a registered volunteer is unable to show up on their assigned day and time of service, they
 - may have someone else attend in their place. They MUST tell the Service Day Chair of this
 - change. The person replacing them MUST know the name of the person they are replacing.
- 4. Organizations must sign in at their assigned check in location on their day of service.
- 5. Each volunteer must show up for registration at least five minutes before, to ensure a timely

release.
