Donation Creation

Tuesday, February 9, 2021 10:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. Student Recreation & Wellness Center (SRWC)

Rules:

- 1. Any student group may enter. There will be a limit on the number (4) of students the group may use to create its display at one time. Safe social distancing will be enforced while creating their display.
- 2. Groups may use any non perishable food item to create its display. **ALL** products must be within expiration date. (Hygiene products are acceptable / e.g., toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, razors)
- 3. A minimum of 100 items per group must be used. Items will be counted by the HLC Donation Creation chair(s). There is no maximum on the number of items per group.
- 4. Groups may not damage the packaging of products with adhesive agents such as scotch tape, duct tape, glue or other sealants. Writing directly on the products is not allowed.
- 5. All groups are **REQUIRED** to **save their boxes and pick up trash** when their display is complete by 3:00 p.m. on Feb. 9, 2021.
 - Groups will also be **REQUIRED** to **help tear down and haul their display items to the Campus Cupboard** after the rally on Feb. 12, 2021.
- 6. NO Chalking Allowed.
- 7. <u>Creation "locations"</u> will be assigned upon arrival at the SRWC on February 9, 2021. Each location will be approximately 6'x 6'. A template may be provided.
- 8. All creations are encouraged to include school spirit and be supportive of the UCM community.
- 9. Award placement will be based on the total number of pounds for their display items.
- 10. One person from each organization is <u>required to check in between 10:00-11:00 a.m. and be</u> <u>completed by 3:00 p.m.</u>
- 11. Items used in the displays will be donated to the UCM Campus Cupboard.
- 12. Creations will remain on display until the end of the rally on Fri., Feb. 12th.
