The Norris J. Freeman Memorial Transportation Scholarship is available through the University of Central Missouri Foundation for a student pursuing a degree in safety sciences with an emphasis in transportation safety. This scholarship is made possible by way of gifts from family and friends in memory of Norris J. Freeman in conjunction with the Missouri Motor Carriers Association of Jefferson City, Missouri.

SCHOLARSHIP BACKGROUND:

This scholarship is to honor Norris J. Freeman, who distinguished himself as a leader in the field of transportation safety. Mr. Norris served with the Commercial Motor Vehicle Enforcement Division of the Missouri State Highway Patrol, Interstate Commerce Interstate Commerce Commission as well as the United States Department of Transportation.

CRITERIA:

To apply, a student must:

- a. be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at UCM the following academic year;
- b. be pursuing a degree in safety science with an emphasis in transportation safety;
- c. have a minimum overall cumulative GPA of 3.0.

* Preference shall be give to a resident of Missouri and a U.S. citizen.

* The recipient(s) of the Norris J. Freeman Memorial Transportation Scholarship shall be expected to attend the Missouri Motor Carriers Association annual spring banquet held in Jefferson City, MO.

SELECTION PROCESS:

1. The recipient(s) of the Norris J. Freeman Memorial Transportation Scholarship will be recommended by a selection committee designated by the Chair of the Department of Safety Sciences. Undergraduate recipient(s) shall be approved by the UCM Scholarships and Awards Officer. Graduate recipient(s) shall be approved by the Dean of the Graduate School.
2. The application must be delivered or postmarked by **November 1**. Recipient(s) shall be announced by December 15 of any given year.
3. The Selection Committee, with the approval of the donor and the Executive Director of the Foundation, will annually establish the number and award amount. If adequate funding is not available, the Selection Committee may exercise the option of making no selection.
