#### **VALIDITY OF THIS TRANSFER GUIDE**

This guide is based on the UCM 2018 Undergraduate Catalog and is subject to change. This guide is a recommendation only and your actual program may vary. Time to degree completion and course sequencing will depend on any credits transferred to UCM and on planned placement in math, reading, and writing. See the current UCM Undergraduate Catalog and MCC Course Catalog for a complete listing of academic policies, curriculum, prerequisites, and course descriptions.

#### **GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

Students who hold an Associate in Arts Degree from MCC or have met the Missouri 42-hour General Education Core requirements are considered to have fulfilled all UCM General Education requirements, except specific general educations classes required by this major. Lists of General Education Requirements can be found in the UCM Catalog.

For those students with an associate degree other than the Associate of Arts or who have not completed the A.A. degree, transfer courses are evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

### **REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS MAJOR**

- Minimum hours: 120
- Minimum of 30 hours upper level credit (courses numbered 300 and above). Courses taken at MCC do not count toward the upper-level requirement though they sometimes may be articulated as upper level classes.
- Minimum of 12 upper level credit hours in major
- Minor requirement: Yes

# RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR A DEGREE AT UCM

- 30 credit hours must be completed at UCM
- 20 upper level hours must be completed at UCM
- 15 credit hours in the major must be from UCM
- 9 upper level hours in the major must be completed at UCM
- The last 12 credit hours must be earned from UCM.
- If pursuing a minor, a minimum of 9 hours in the minor must be completed at UCM. There must also be at least one upper level hour completed at UCM.

#### **GPA REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION**

Students must achieve a minimum GPA of 2.00 in all GPAs to qualify for graduation. This includes cumulative GPA, UCM GPA, major GPA, and minor GPA (if applicable). Some degrees have additional GPA requirements.

#### TRANSFER WORK

Arrange for all transfer work to be posted at UCM at the time of application. An official transcript must be received at UCM directly from each school attended. Transcripts can be sent to University of Central Missouri, Office of Admissions, 1400 Ward Edwards, Warrensburg, MO 64093. #### **DUAL ADMISSION**
