Project Lead The Way® (PLTW) is a not-for-profit organization that promotes pre-engineering courses for middle and high school students. PLTW forms partnerships with public schools, higher education institutions and the private sector to increase the quantity and quality of engineers and engineering technologists graduating from our educational system.

UCM offers college credit for qualified high school Project Lead the Way® courses. Upon completion of the course(s) students can apply the credits toward their degree programs.

Qualifications:

- Complete any PLTW course available for credit at UCM while in high school
- AND**
- Earn a final course grade of B, or higher, in the course(s)
- AND**
- Earn a score at the "Accomplished" or "Distinguished" level on the national EOC exam for PBS and HBS
- OR**
- Be recommended for credit by your MI/BI PLTW teachers.

Required Documents:

- Signed Engineering Application
- OR**
- Signed Biomedical Application
- Official Signed High School Transcripts
- Official EOC Scores *(Biomedical Innovations not required)*
- FERPA *(optional for students 18 and older)*
- Tuition (\$99.50 per credit hour)

Teacher To Complete:

Cooperative Agreement

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Teacher's documents only necessary for instructor stipend payment.

Application Deadline:

You can apply for PLTW credit once the course is over during your time in high school.

The credit opportunity expires one year after high school graduation.
