UCM KC Scholar Award

Traditional Student Scholarship:

This Scholarship will cover the cost to attend UCM that is placed on the student's account to include tuition, general fees, textbooks, residence halls, and meal plan. This is a last dollar scholarship that will pay for any remaining appliable charges the student has after all federal, state, institutional, and other scholarships have been applied to the student's account. The student will be responsible for any required course fees for all programs and flight fees associated with the aviation program. If the student does have charges for Pilot Supplies, UCM will pay a one-time \$200 payment if eligible for the UCM scholarship.

Adult Learner Scholarship:

This Scholarship will cover cost to attend UCM that is placed on the student's account to include tuition, general fees, and textbooks throughout the year after all federal, state, institutional, and other scholarships have been applied to the student's account. The student will be responsible to pay any required course fees and housing if they decide to live on campus.

Requirements:

The requirements for the scholarship are a GPA of 2.0 or greater and filing the FAFSA of each academic year and complete verification, if required. A high school cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required and once Scholars are enrolled at UCM, they must maintain a cumulative overall GPA of 2.0 or greater each academic year to be eligible.

Additionally:

- This scholarship cannot be used for penalty charges (i.e. Health center charges, Non return of rental textbooks, library penalty charges, parking fines, etc.)
- The UCM scholarship will be applied after all other KC Scholar, federal, state, and institutional aid has been applied. Funds will be applied to remaining cost that meets the rules stated above.
- The UCM Scholarship will cover up to the \$19,000 total per student for the remaining costs. UCM will fill the remaining unmet need up to \$19,000 an academic year.

Awarding:

If Eligible this award will be processed after the first week of each semester. It will be applied to your account prior to the first payment plan fee being charged.
