- *Students must earn 30 hours of 3000/4000 level classes to graduate. Courses may be taken as a combination of criminal justice electives and/or general education courses.
- * Students who graduated from CCAF during the 2017-2021 catalog year will have different communications requirements; however, students will still receive 6 hours of communications credit based on their official CCAF transcripts.
- **Service members who have been through basic training receive a total of 11 credit hours from our university. GNED 1925 3 credit hours (Elective Area General Education), HLTH 1100 3 credit hours (Electives), CJ 3005 3 credit hours (Criminal Justice electives) and remaining 2 credit hours (Electives).
- ^Courses that concurrently satisfy both a general education and a requirement within the core
- *** ACST 1300 Basic Statistics is highly recommended as the general education mathematics class. The prerequisite is MATH 1101 Intermediate Algebra.
- ^^If testing credit such as CLEP or DSST was used to complete CCAF general education requirements, credit will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
