SPRING 2023 **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES:** I understand this is an application for exemption from UCM's residential policy, BOG policy 5.1.020. Release from requirement is subject to approval by the office of University Housing at the University of Central Missouri. If denied, I am required to carry out the residential requirement of residing on campus or pay the applicable penalty fee. It is not recommended to make off-campus residency plans until official approval is given. If approved, the exemption is for only one academic year (or semester if applied for beginning with spring semester). A new exemption form is required for each additional academic year until residency requirement is satisfied. Students wishing to be exempt for their second year must apply separately. Submission of an exemption request does not supersede or void an existing residence hall agreement (unless submitting prior to start of fall semester). Student athletes on scholarship who receive aid that covers more than 12 credit hours of in state tuition per semester are not eligible for exemption from on campus residency. An approved exemption will be nullified should a student then receive an athletic scholarship covering more than 12 credit hours of in state tuition.
