

University of Central Missouri – University Housing Early Arrival Information – Fall 2025

Welcome to UCM. Here is some information for you to have since you are arriving prior to our large move-in days.

- 1. Room doors may be open to rooms before opening due to last checks of rooms by staff. Do not enter any rooms without authorization. Entering rooms that are not yours, as well as tampering, removing, or moving furniture, is not permitted. Students found doing so will be documented through our conduct process and asked to leave until our large move-in day, no exemptions. You may also be referred for student conduct purposes.
- 2. Your room key will allow entry to your room and building (exception is those issued fobs in The Crossing). You may need to turn your key and push the metal button on the door (if applicable) to open. We are working on mobile ID access which may or not be in place upon your arrival.
- 3. Dining Centers are not open until Thursday, August 14 for dinner. Please check with your early arrival group (if applicable) if meals are provided to your group.
- 4. Loft rentals are not available for pick up until August 14. Please see email that will be sent with those details and pick-up locations. For fridges/microwaves, you will be emailed regarding that information.
- 5. If you need emergency assistance including lockouts, facility emergencies (leaks, power outages, etc.), please contact us:
 - a. Monday-Friday, 8 am 5 pm, University Housing: 660-543-4515
 - b. After 5 PM, Monday Friday and on weekends, On-Call staff: 660-441-1337
- 6. Please be sure to complete your room/apartment condition inventory sheet provided upon check-in. You MUST return this during the next early arrival period or move-in date to the staff working the desk/check-in staff. Periods you can return your condition inventory:
 - a. August 2, 10 am 12 pm
 - b. August 9, 1-4 pm
 - c. August 11, 1-4 pm
 - d. August 14, 9 am 3 pm (residence halls only)
 - e. August 17, 9 am 3 pm

Failure to return your inventory will result in you being charged for any damages found at the end of the year in your room.
