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REQUIREMENTS FOR THIS MAJOR

- Minimum hours: 124 – 128.5
- Minimum of 30 hours upper level credit (courses numbered 3000 and above). Courses taken at MCC do not count toward the upper-level requirement though they sometimes may be articulated as upper level classes.
- Minimum of 12 upper level credit hours in major
- Minor requirement: No
- Modern language requirement: No

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR A DEGREE AT UCM

- 30 credit hours must be completed at UCM
- 20 upper level hours must be completed at UCM
- 15 credit hours in the major must be from UCM
- 9 upper level hours in the major must be completed at UCM
- The last 12 credit hours must be earned from UCM
- If pursuing a minor, a minimum of 9 hours in the minor must be completed at UCM. There must also be at least one upper level hour completed at UCM.

TRANSFER WORK

Arrange for all transfer work to be posted at UCM at the time of application. An official transcript must be received at UCM directly from each school attended. *PERSONAL INTERACTION

UCM recommends students take PHIL 203 Ethics or SPDR 103 Interpersonal Communication within the Humanities section of the A.A. to fulfill the UCM Personal Interaction requirement. PHIL 203 or SPDR 103 will not be necessary for students who have already taken a Personal Interaction class. Other MCC classes that fulfill Personal Interaction are: PSYC 144, HUMS 210, BSAD 120, PHED 157, 126, 127, 128, and 129. If no transfer work satisfies Personal Interaction, it must be completed at UCM.
