What to Bring:

- Valid driver's license or photo id card
- Social Security card, Social Security Number (SSN) verification letter, or Individual Taxpayer Identifying Number (ITIN) for all persons listed on return
- Birth dates for all persons listed on return
- All income statements: Forms W-2 and 1099, Social Security, unemployment, other statements such as pensions, dividends, interest, and any documents showing taxes withheld
- All records of expenses such as tuition, books, and student loan interest
- Copies of last year's state and federal tax returns, if available
- Bank routing numbers and account numbers to direct deposit any refund
- Dependent child care information: name and address of who you paid and caretaker's SSN or other tax ID number
- Both spouses must be present to sign forms to e-file a joint tax return
