SEEK OUT REFERENCES

To complete your application, you will require three to five letters of reference.

Consider approaching professors, university personnel, former employers, and professional contacts for this purpose. When providing information to your references, include details about your relevant experiences and the programs you are considering. It is courteous to request references at least two weeks in advance.

PREPARE APPLICATIONS & REVIEW

Prepare comprehensive application materials, including a curriculum vitae, resume, personal statement, and essays of intent. Request transcripts from all attended colleges, bearing in mind that different schools may require varying information. Ensure the completeness and error-free quality of your materials by having professors and Career Services review them.
